

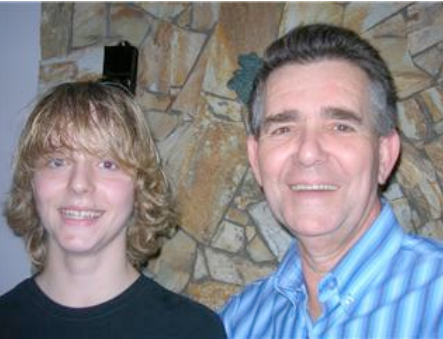

Ralph and Nick Terpstra), the Guatemalans who they will be ministering to, and Chris and Donna Mooney (the directors of Bethel Ministries International).

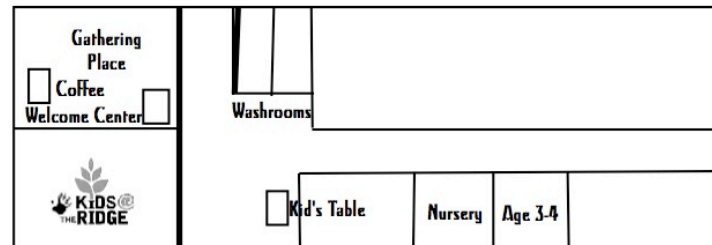
