Junghoon and Pearl Lim (Suji, Sumin & Suyoung) serving in SE Asia: Our family is taking the Cross Cultural Living Internship under the guidance of senior members. Pray that He would give them joy and wisdom as they help and guide us and for our clear understanding of the culture and adjustment to it.

Junghoon has decided to go to the Dynamic Language Center to take Malay course which will begin on April 14th . Please pray for the enthusiasm he needs to learn the national language.

We praise the Lord for giving us a smooth transition and settlement here in Penang. However, there is one challenges in terms of children's education. Currently, while our first daughter Suji is going to Dalat International School (Grade 1), Sumin (five years old) is staying at home because there was no room for him at the school when we applied for the school last year. It's true that he may be able to go to other schools around and we actually tried, but he has been wanting to go to DIS with his sister. So he just has been with us at home waiting for the next year. Recently, we had heard that he would be accepted to the kindergarten for the next year. However, we just got an email from DIS that they cannot give us an definite answer on his acceptance due to the limitation of the class size. They found out that none of students from the lower years will be leaving next year. So they will be making a decision whether they will be increasing the cut off limit for the class or not next month. Please pray for this situation. Junghoon will start going to language school soon and Pearl also wants to start language learning from a tutor. But with two young boys at home, that would be really hard! Pray for peace in our mind and good solution of this challenge.

### Little Dane Suderman:

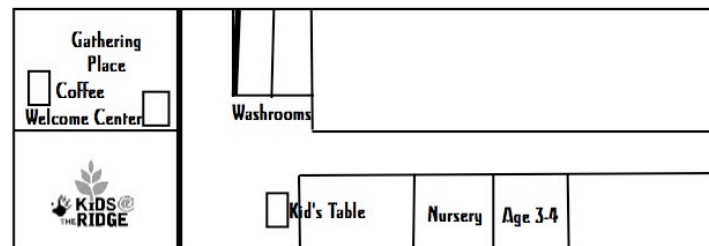

### Map of RE Secondary School

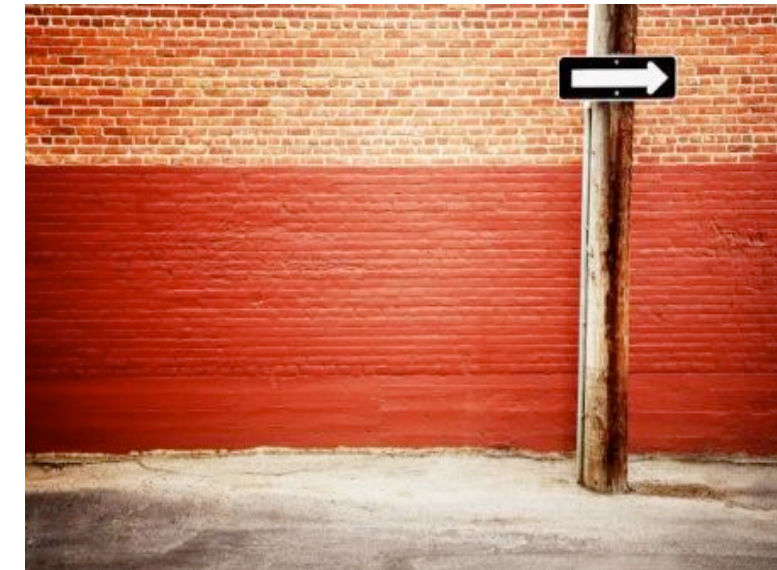

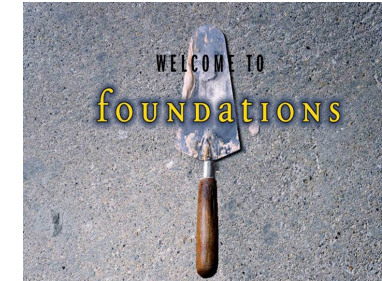
### Nursery Worker Position Available:
