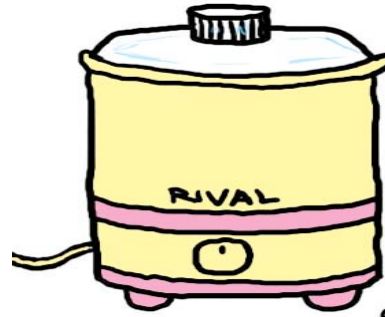
Welcome:

Joint Gathering with The Willows:



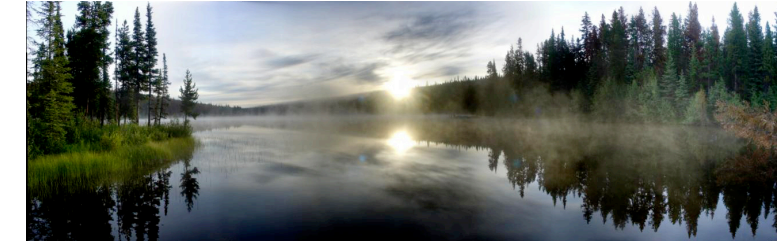

Men's Rustic Fishing Weekend:

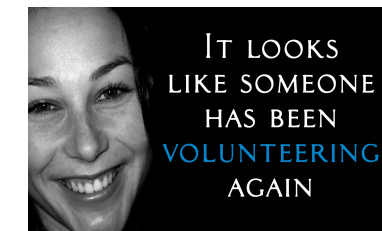
