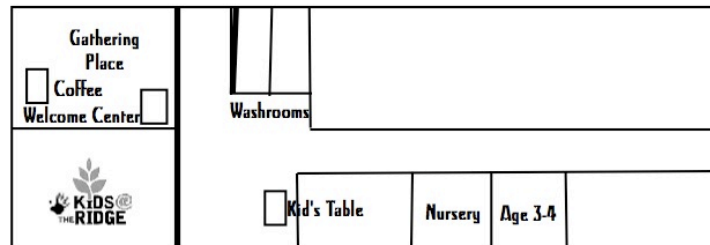

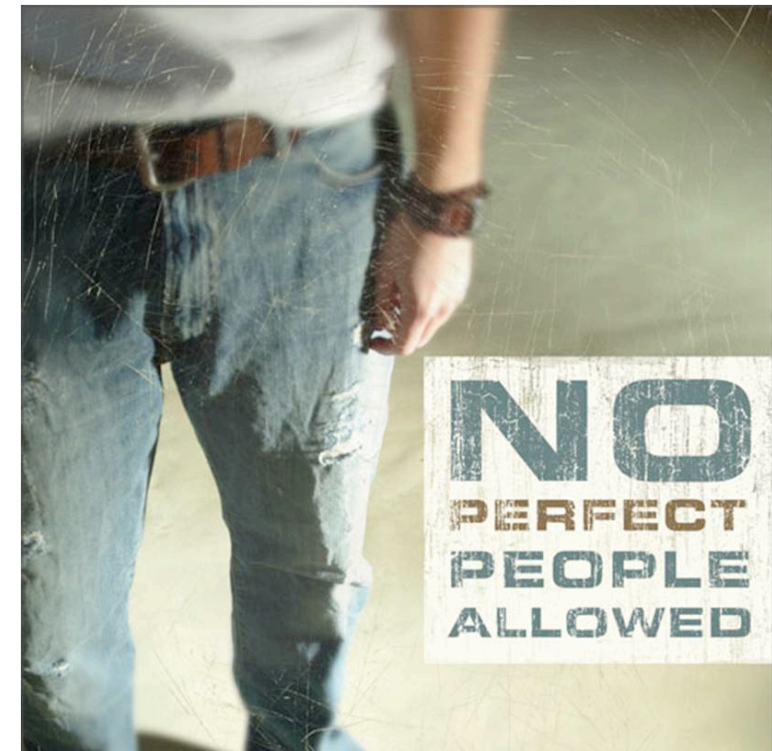
Map of RE Secondary School
