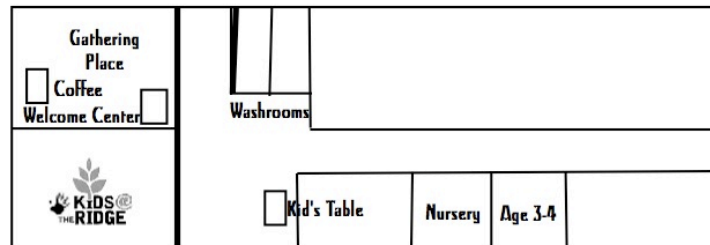

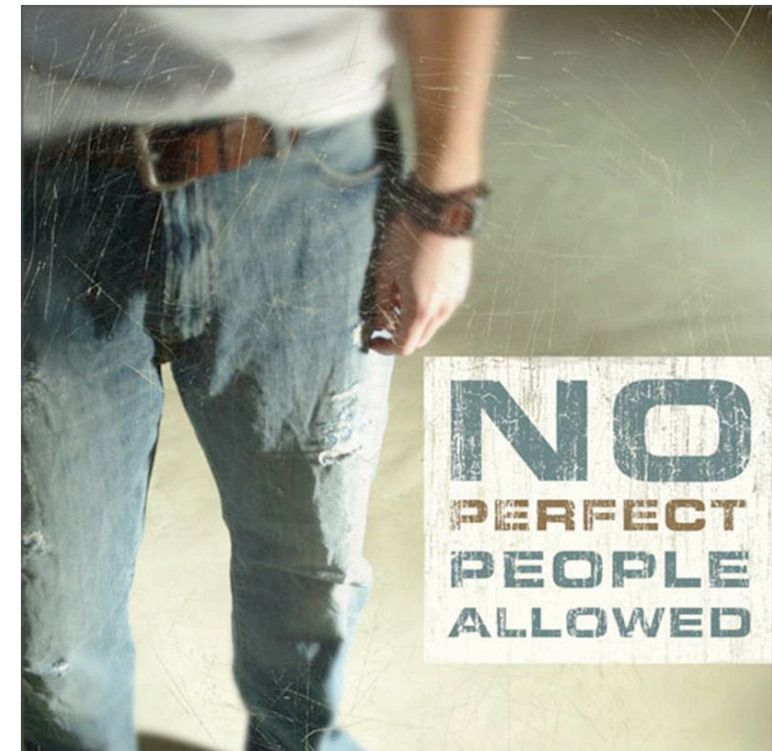
### Map of RE Secondary School

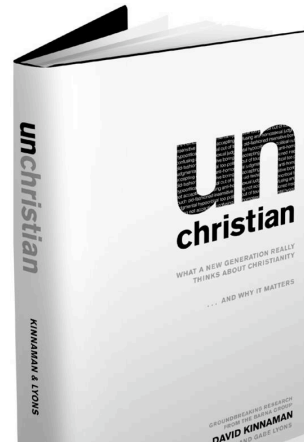
### Mennonite Heritage Cup:
