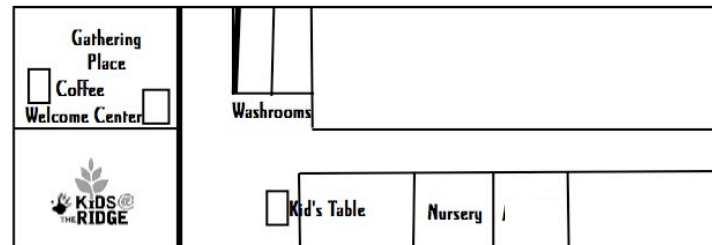

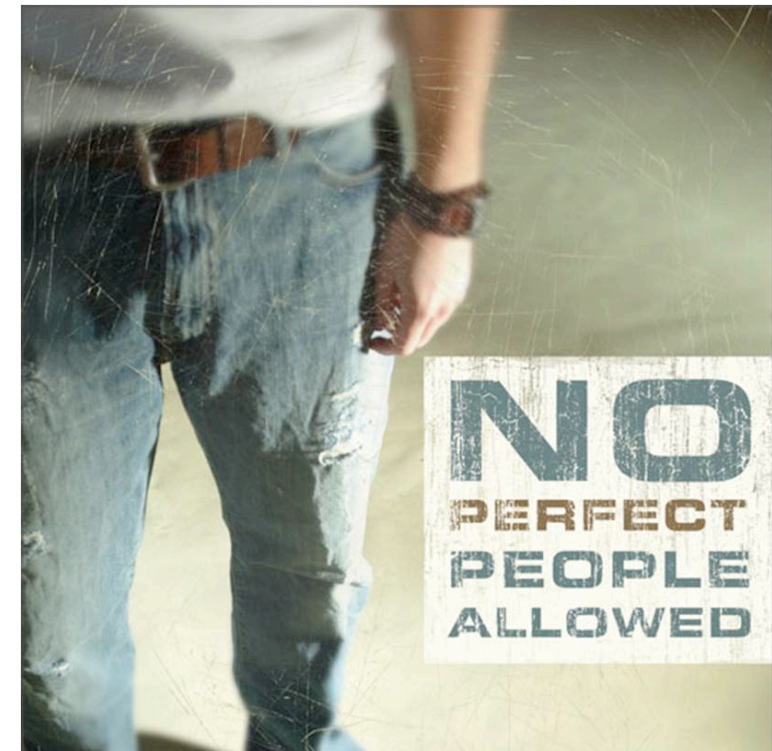
### Map of RE Secondary School

### Men's Accountability Group:

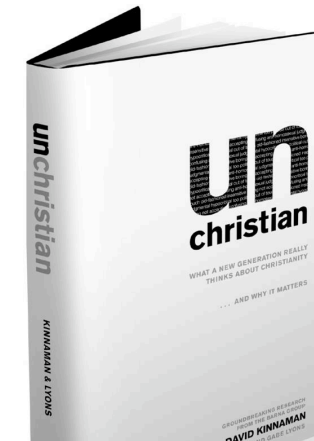
