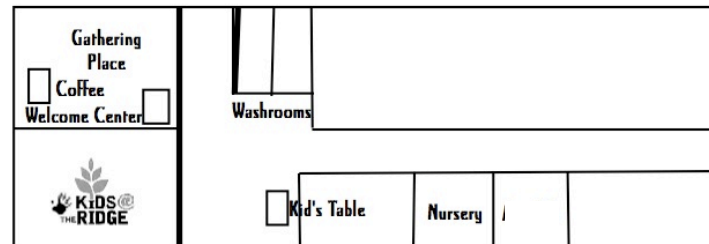

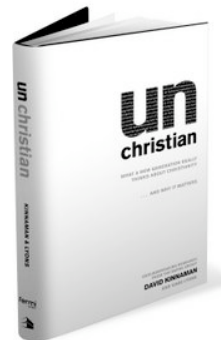
FALL KICK OFF:

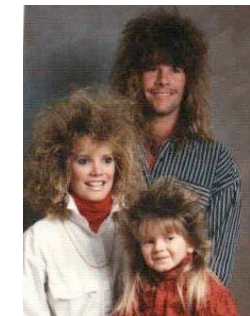
