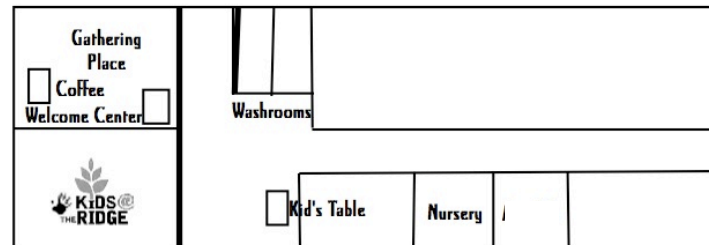

## Herconnecting Summer Schedule:

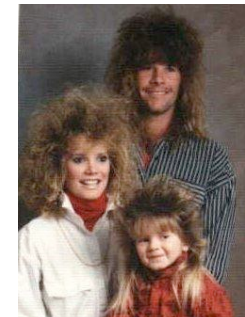
