· Please pray for the health of Pam Price’s mother. She has been sick with a lung infection for over five weeks and she has other lung and heart problems which are making her condition worse.

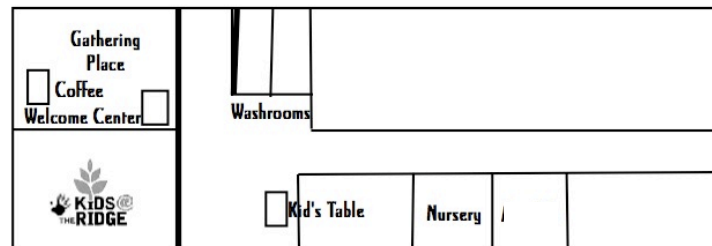
