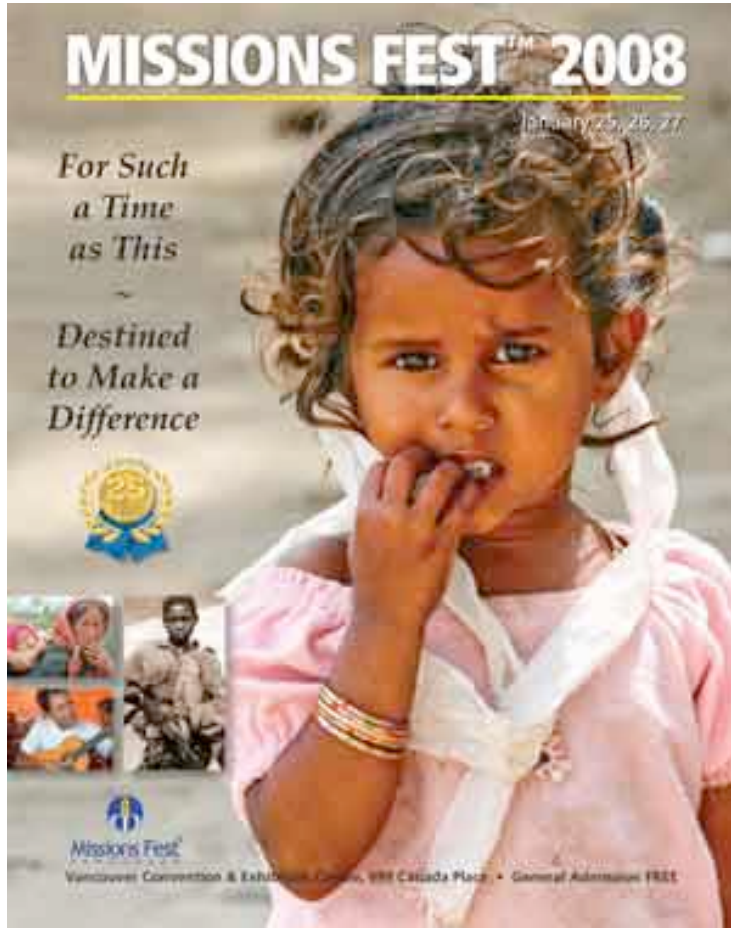


IMAGINE A PLACE WHERE:

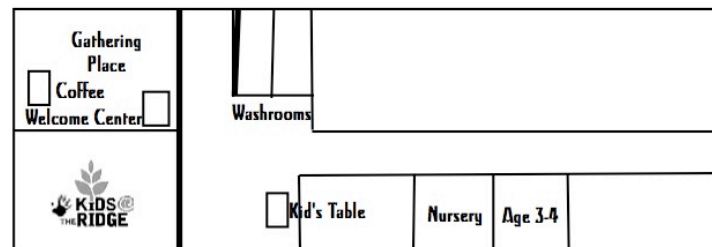
Join the thousands who attend, learn about developments not reported in the media, interact with international guests, be stimulated and challenged to make your life count by reaching out effectively to a needy world.
