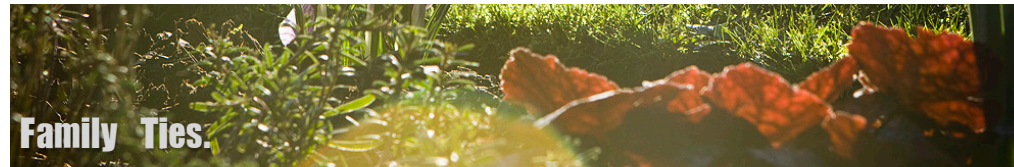

Congrats, Grads!

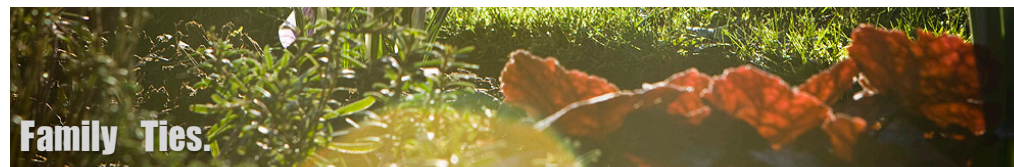

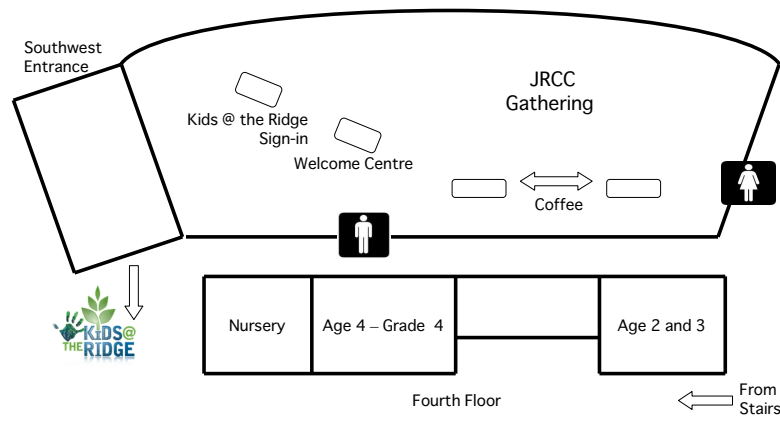

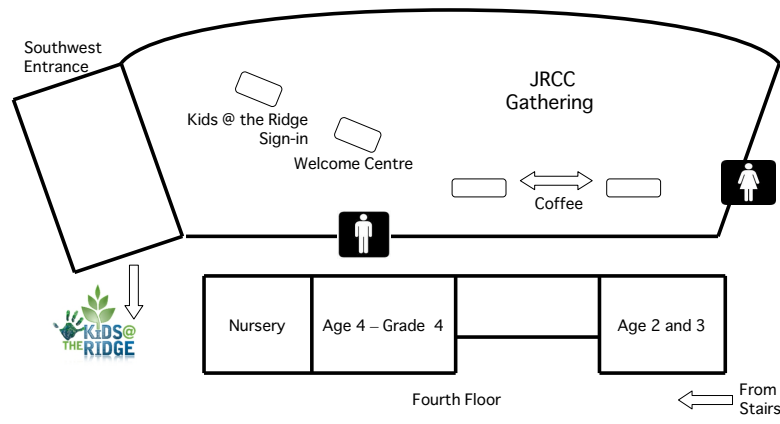
