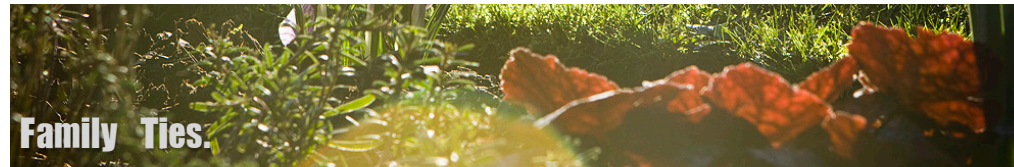

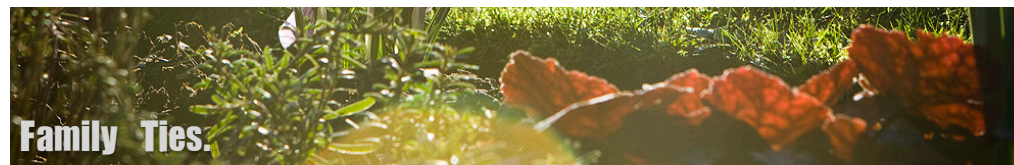


Lucas Brian Charlebois

May 28th from 6:30-9:30 PM; Cost: \$5

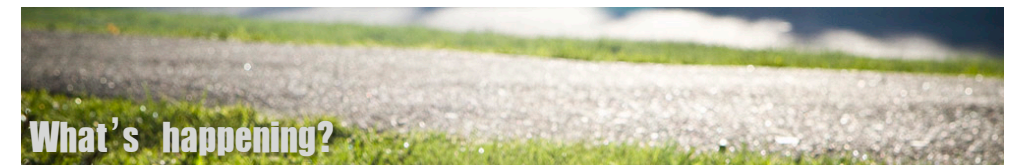

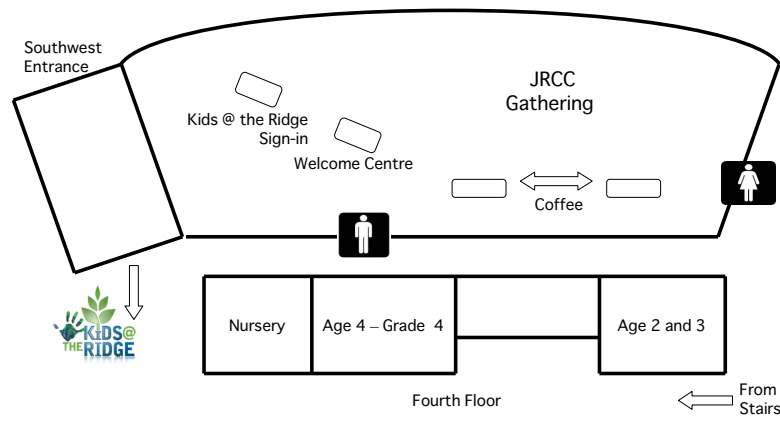

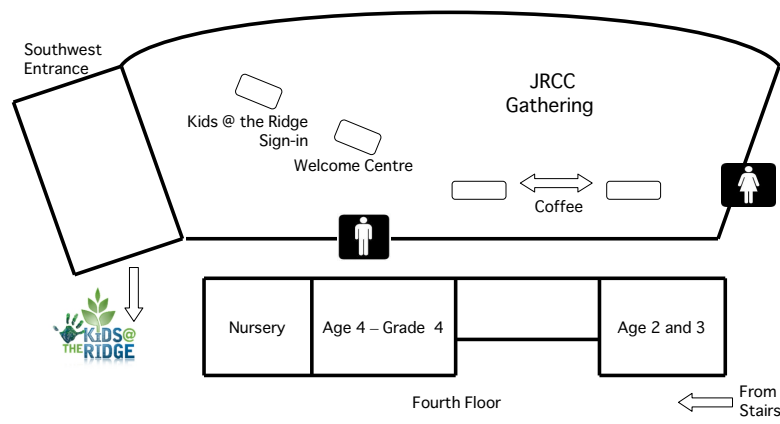
