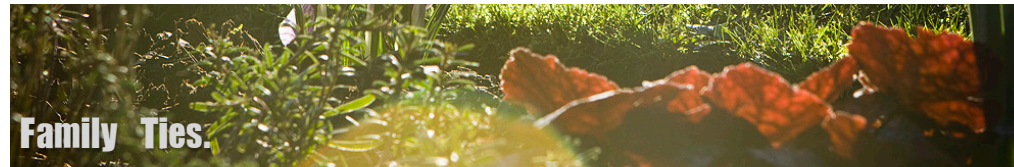

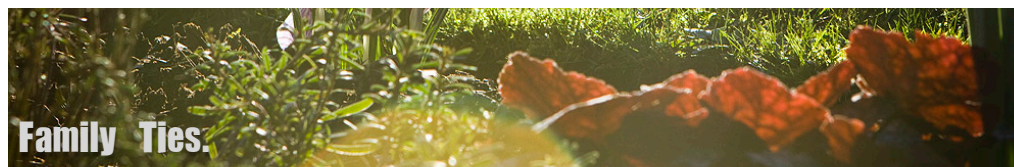


Introducing... Sidney Joy Court

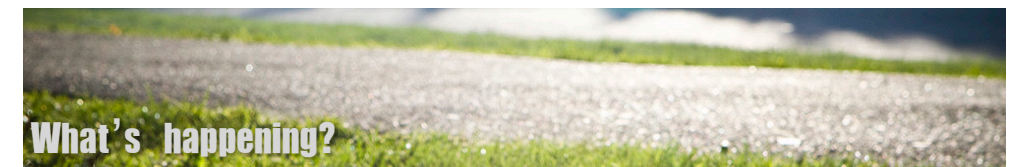

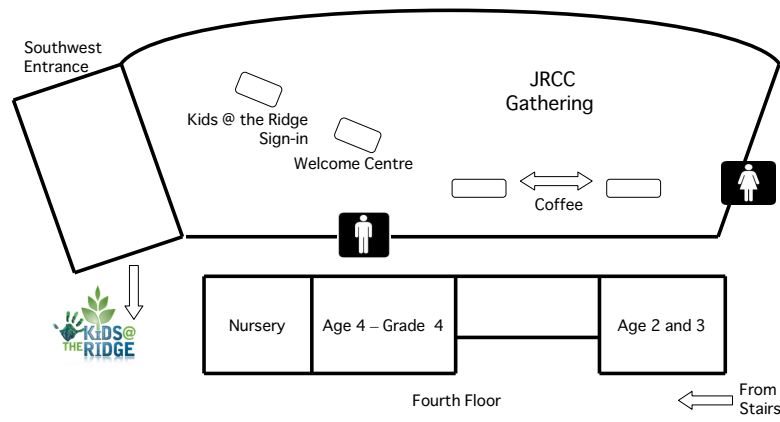
