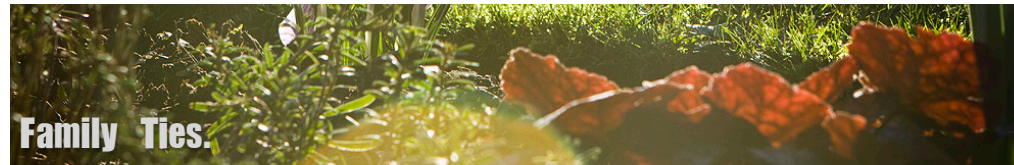

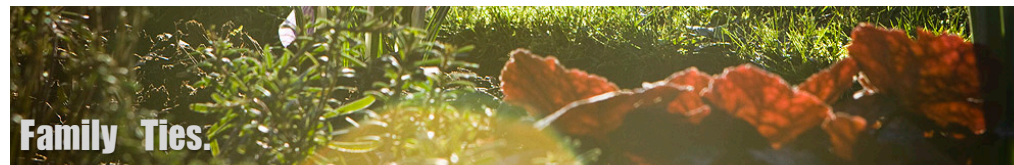

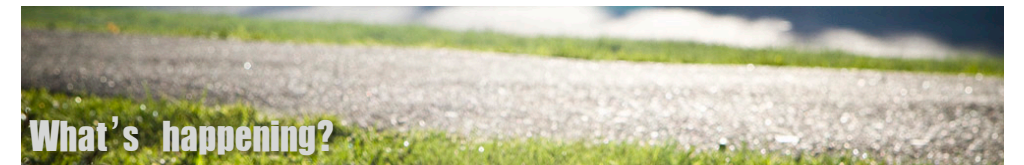
JRCC is very happy to announce that our church office is moving! Our new office location will be in suite #211 – 20740 Mufford Crescent. Here's how you can help:

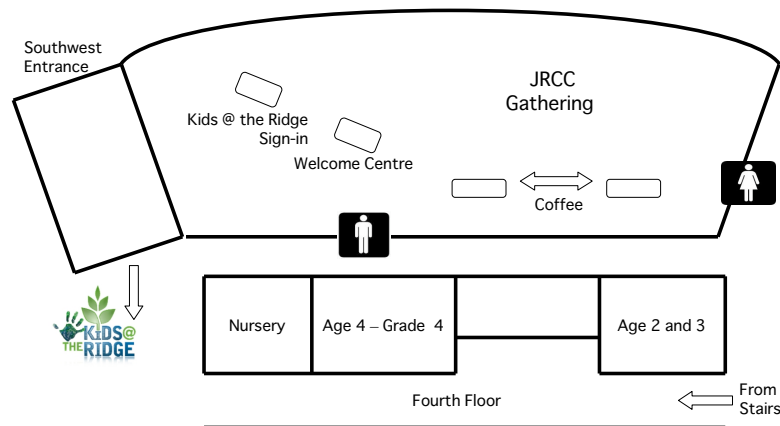

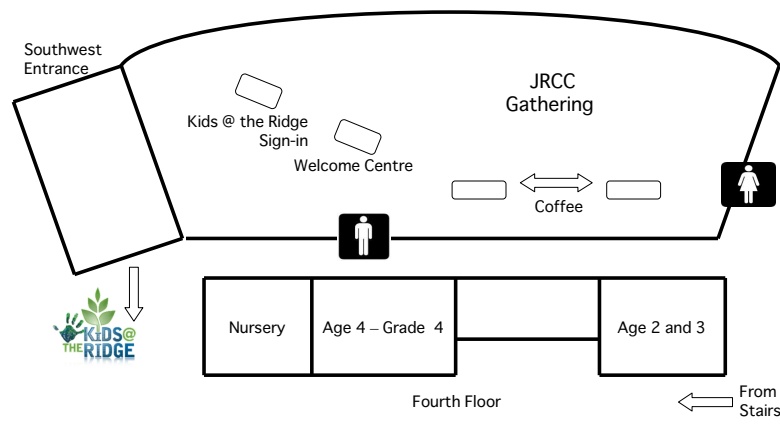
