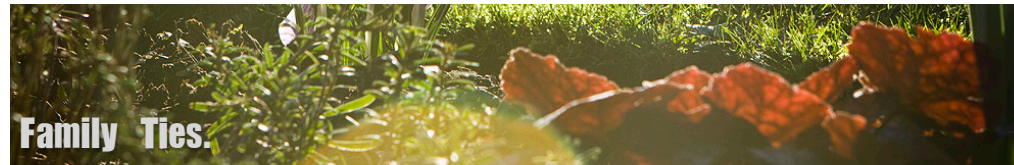

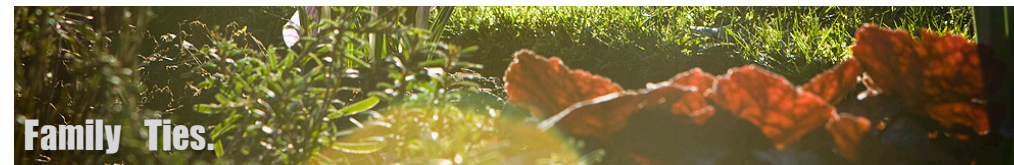


Zorn Family Dedication

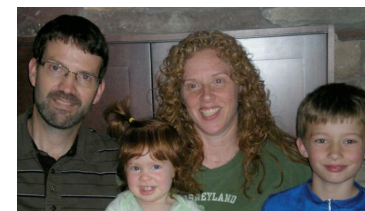

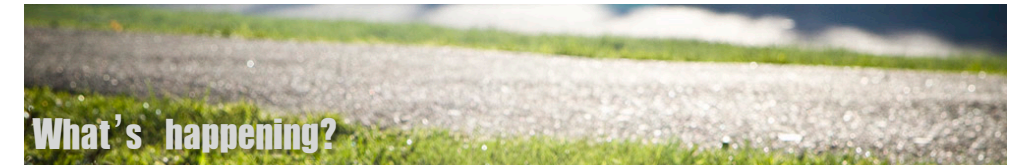


Zorn Family Dedication

Summer Sunday Cinema Sign Up (say it 5 times fast – we dare you!)

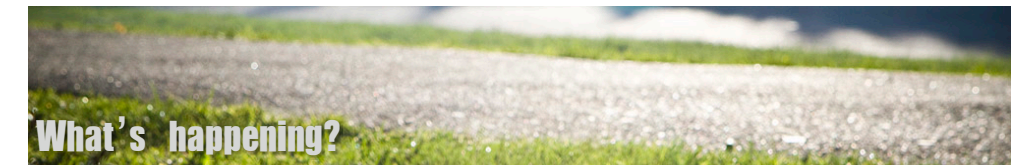
