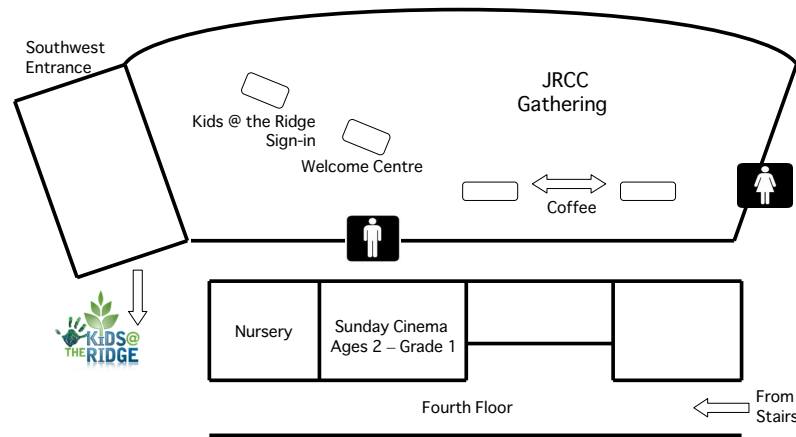


Location map of our Community Pool Party

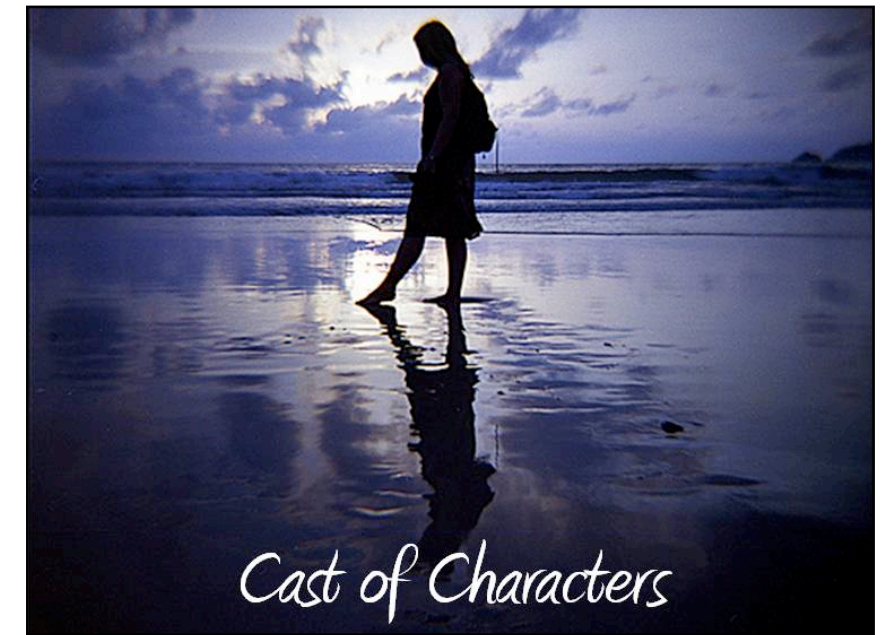

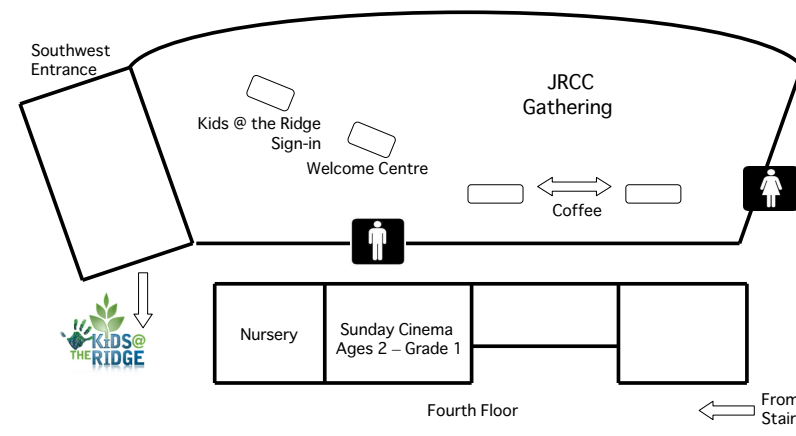


Location map of our Community Pool Party
