Discussion & Application Guide



The purpose of this take-Home sheet is to be a tool to assist you and your family as you build faith in your homes. At Jericho Ridge Community Church we want to equip you with resources to continue the conversation and growth at home. We recognize that, one, parents are the primary influence in building faith in kids. After all, as Mark Holmen says in his book *Building Faith at Home*, research has shown that mom and dad “are two to three times more influential [in faith development] than any church program.” Two, that faith is not just a Sunday morning dress that gets tossed after church but influences and speaks into every aspect of our lives.

Questions for Reflection & Discussion

1) Israel experienced God’s provision many times before arriving at the edge of the promised land (Exodus 14:27-31, 15:22-25, 16:11-18, 17:8-13). Why do you think they continued to doubt God’s ability to provide for them?

2) Are there times in your life where you doubt what God has told you or his ability to provide for you? Are there times in your past where you have seen God provide? Could these experiences help you trust God more?

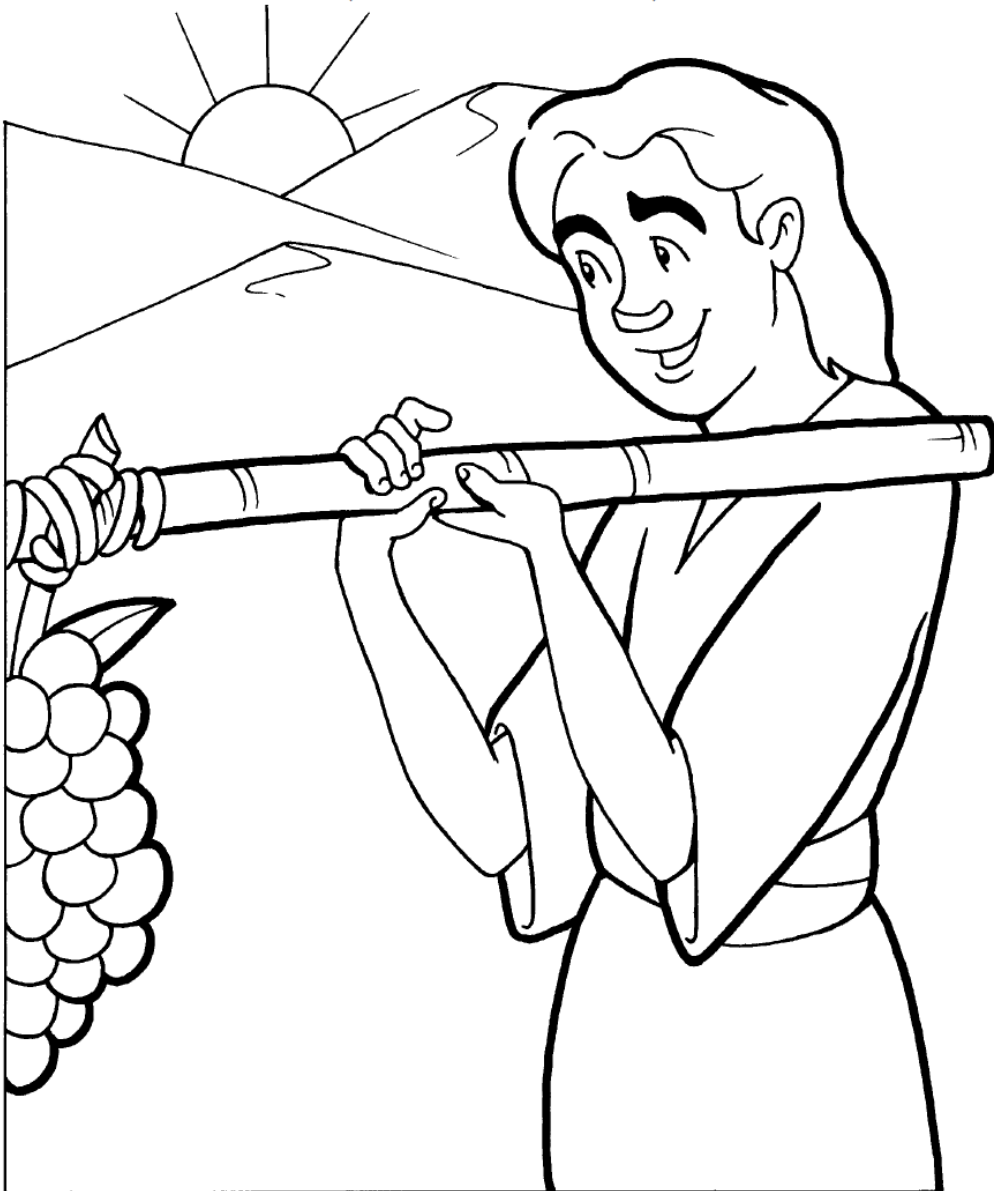
3) Caleb stood up against those who doubted God and spoke the truth of God’s promise (Exodus 23:20-33). Do you have the courage to stand up for God’s truth when you face opposition? What could help you have more courage in this type of situation?

4) Often we look at the visible challenges before us and forget that God is working for us in ways that we can’t see with our human eyes. How can you develop faith to trust God so you can obey and follow him without delay? How can you keep from underestimating God? For a great story about seeing beyond human eyes check out 2 Kings 6:15-23.

5) God said of Caleb “he has had a different spirit and has followed Me fully” (Numbers 14:24). What would it look like to cultivate a different spirit from those around you and follow God fully?
