Sales will take place at both Martinganza and the Tarheel Triple Classic.

GUIDELINES

1. All clothing must be presented on hangers, clean, and in good repair.
2. Hats, boots, and chaps are accepted, but no tack except for color coordinated Western show pads. Hats must be in a box or hat can.
3. **Donations** will be priced by the Amateurs and will be considered their property.
4. **Consignments** may be priced by the consignees. The Amateurs will retain 50% of that price. For items that will sell for \$1,000 or more, the Amateurs will retain 30%.
5. Each consignee must present a list of articles complete with size, price, and a detailed description. (Sheets on which to write this information will be provided.)
6. Amateurs will tag all items.
7. If a consignee does not wish to participate in both venues, it is their responsibility to pick up their property.
8. **Any consignments left after 11:00 am on Saturday, June 16, 2018, in Raleigh at the Tarheel Triple Classic will become the property of the NC Amateur Quarter Horse Association and will be considered a donation.**
9. All consigned items are left at the owners risk. We do our best to protect your property, but are not responsible for losses due to theft, fire, flood, or accidental damage.
10. Consignees can expect to be paid on or around April 30th and then again on June 30th. Checks will be mailed at that time.

For best sales exposure, please bring your items as early as 3pm on Wednesday, April 4, 2018 to Martinganza in Williamston. We will be located across from the cafe in the coliseum.

We will also be accepting items at the Tarheel Triple Classic as early as 3pm on Wednesday, June 13, 2018 in Raleigh. We will be located in the Horse Master barn next to the food tent.
