Getting Started

Are you generally open to being disturbed? Why or why not?

Why do you think the average person is not open to being disturbed?

Greg said on Sunday that to be a disciple of Jesus you must first allow Jesus to disturb you. What do you think about this statement? Do you agree or disagree?

In what ways has Jesus disturbed your life?

Digging Deeper

Read Luke 5:1-11.

In what way did Jesus disturb Peter’s routine (vs. 1-3)?

In what ways does Jesus disturb your daily or weekly routine (for example, think about the times when Jesus has placed opportunities in your path to bless others)?

How did Jesus disturb Peter’s thinking (vs.4-9)?

In what ways does Jesus disturb your thinking? If He has not done so, talk about why this is the case.

How did Jesus disturb Peter’s aspirations (vs. 10-11)?

What role should Jesus have in our plans and aspirations?

Bringing It Home

Peter dropped his net to follow Jesus. In a very real way, the net represented Jesus’ identity. It was how he made a living. He would have been known as a fisherman. What “net” do you need to drop in order to follow Jesus?

How can the group better pray for you in this area?
