- How do we play a part in bringing glory to God?

### **Bringing It Home**

- What are some of the accepted 'norms' in the church concerning outreach, evangelism, and missions?
- Have you ever used a rationalization (such as "I'm not called to go overseas" or "There are enough needs here at home") to avoid personally taking part in God's global mission? What do you think about those rationalizations now?
- Specifically, how do you think God might want you to help fulfill his global purpose?
- Please read the following story before your group prays.

The Narnias are an unreached people group of 2 million people in North Africa. They are enslaved to the religion of Islam. There is no Bible in their native language. There is no church and no countable Christians. One of our *GO* (Global Outreach) partner families from Cedar Ridge live and work among the Narnians. Daania is one of the people God has brought into the lives of our *GO* Partners. She is a single lady in her early twenties and has just finished studying at the university in her city. She is very intelligent. She is a devout Muslim and has been recently studying the Old Testament in the original languages in order to be a better Muslim. Our *GO* Partners have had several opportunities to share the good news of Jesus with Daania. They say, "She knows what it means to follow Jesus. All she lacks is to take the first step. All that is left for us to do is to pray for her."

This week, would you as a group pause and pray for Daania? Ask God to open her heart to the love of Jesus. Ask God to draw her close to His side. Pray that she would be a completely devoted follower of Jesus. Pray also for the Narnians. Pray that many would turn toward Jesus and that a church would be birth among them.
