What are specific ways we an make sure that Jesus remains the first love of our life and the first love in the life of the local church?

Read Revelation 3:14-21

What does it look like when the church becomes lukewarm and what can we do to make sure our church stays hot for God?

It is a serious and sobering reality that all people will spend eternity in heaven or hell. How does the book of Revelation affirm this reality and how should this spur us to share the message and love of Jesus with the people in our life?

John offered us a vision of what heaven will be like (Revelation 21:1-22:5). What specific element of this vision makes you excited to spend eternity in this glorious place?

Name one person you love who is already with Jesus. How does the hope of seeing this person again make heaven even more wonderful?

What can you do on a daily basis to stay close to God and have a dynamic friendship with him?
