Digging Deeper

Read [John 6:11-13](#)

Once again, Jesus has compassion on the crowds so He taught them, healed them and also fed them. What does this say about how Jesus’ feelings towards us?

Read [John 6: 26-27](#)

It becomes clear that the people follow Jesus and want Him to be their king because He gave them free food. Why doesn’t Jesus comply with the crowd’s request for more food?

What wrong motives for following Jesus can you name? What are the right reasons to follow Jesus?

Bringing It Home

What does it mean to be more interested in the spiritual rather than the fleshly?

What does it look like to follow Jesus when it’s difficult or when it doesn’t make sense?

What does it mean to recognize that it is only by the grace of God that we are drawn to Him? (John 6:44)

Why do you think some people deserted Jesus after His teaching on the bread of life? How does this same thing happen in today’s world?
