Getting Started

When you hear the word discipleship, what comes to your mind?

Digging Deeper

Read Luke 15

Parables are stories that help to teach a point. What is the point of these 3 parables? How can you apply that point to your life today?

What do the parables about the lost sheep, coin, and son show us about the heart of God for people who are lost?

Read Luke 18:18-25

It is obvious that the man’s wealth is what was standing in the way between him and Jesus, what things can get in the between you and Jesus?

Jesus told the rich man to sell everything and give it all away, but he couldn’t do it. If we truly believe that God will one day reward his children in heaven, why are we reluctant to make sacrifices for God?

Read John 12:1-8

Why do you think Jesus reacted the way he did to what Mary was doing?

What do you think Jesus means in verses 7 and 8?

Bringing It Home

This entire section is about discipleship. If we are going to be true disciples, what costs do we need to count when responding to Jesus? (Luke 14:28-33)

In the story of the 10 lepers (Luke 17) we see just one of the 10 coming back to thank Jesus. How can we be more intentional about thanking God for the work he has done in our lives?

The message had 3 things that discipleship is...servant hood, humility, and worship. Which one is the easiest for you? Which one is the hardest? Why?
