Narrator

God made lots of things to grow. Have you ever planted a little seed? Little seeds can grow into big gardens. This week we have been talking about how God's word helps us grow from little seeds to God's big helpers!

Memory Verse (Special Part)

There are some people who have no desire to learn more about God, these people are like the seeds that fall on the path. Narrator

These people worry more about men, than they do about God. Kids should we care more about our friends think or about what God thinks?

Narrator

Yes, your little farmers are so smart! They know they have to be rooted deep in God's Word to be fully ready at Harvest time.

Song: Harvest Time

Harvest Time reminds us that:

Narrator

That's right kids. Jesus said, "Other seed fell among the thorns, which grew up and choked the plants."

Another words some people hear the God's Word, but they are more worried about their day to day activities and spend their time trying to get more money.

Children

Money, Money

Narrator

Yes, some people think the more money they have the happier the will be. Sadly this just isn't true. People can only be truly happy when they have a genuine friendship with God, through His son <u>Jesus</u>.

Jesus is my friend!

Narrator

Yes kids, Jesus is your friend! Will you sing to him and make him your NUMBER ONE?

Memory Verse (Special Part)

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing."

Song: Will you sing?

1. Will you sing, will you sing to the King? Praising Jesus and following him?

If we try to follow God's Word and tell other about him then that shows that He is Lord of our lives. And although we can't work our way into heaven, these are signs that He is Lord of our lives. We must sow the seed, till the ground and then wait and trust until God's purpose has been fulfilled.
