JEAN: **You're right. How could I forget? Cassie's mom was supposed to chaperone today. I got a message last night saying Cassie's mom was sick. So, we're short one chaperone . . . and one Cassie. Carson?**

CARSON: **Yes ma'am?**

ASSISTANT: *(moves to another part of the audience)* **Can you hear me now?**

DAD: **Joan, you're breaking up but go ahead.**

ASSISTANT: **Rollie, where are you? Things are a zoo at the office today!**

DAD: **It's a jungle out here too!**

CASSIE: *(explains to kids)* **My Dad is Head of Marketing for a clothing company. He is supposed to be at a big meeting today, but he came here to help me.**

(music begins to “King of the Jungle”)

DAD: **Cassie, don’t talk so much. I can’t hear Joan.**

ASSISTANT: **Rollie, the president is going to be here in an hour and you need to tell me what to tell him! He’s an animal when he doesn’t get what he wants.**

CASSIE: **Dad!** *(reaching for the cell phone to hang it up)*

DAD: **Cassie, please don’t . . . honey, the clock is ticking.** *(to assistant)* **Don’t worry, I’ll call you. Joan, don’t worry. Have I ever let you down before?**

ASSISTANT: **Don’t get me started.**

DAD: *(call is lost)* **Joan? . . . Joan?**
