Getting Started

Digging Deeper

Read Micah 6:6-8

What is it that God is NOT after? What IS he after from His people? What do you think this indicates about the state of Israel at the time?

Read Nahum 1:3-8

How is God's power described in verses 3-6? Does the God described in these verses seem incapable of anything?

There is a strong contrast in how God deals with those who trust in Him and how He deals with those who do not (vs. 7-8). What are the differences? Does that seem fair to you?

Bring It Home

Greg said, "Micah reminds us in the midst of our sin, that we serve a God who pardons sin by coming to this earth and taking the punishment himself." Why is this a good reminder for all of us?

Why is it important to understand that everything God does is so that all will see His glory?

What is one thing that you can **obey** and put into practice in your life from this sermon and/or lesson?
