CD #15: Drama Scene 1 – At the Flagpole

PROP NEEDS: Handwritten letter to Abby’s advice column from “Anonymous”
Alex needs a Bible (when he refers to God’s playbook)
All students (actors and choir members) can have a book, Bible, folder, *Follow U* pennant when they arrive at school.

ABBY: *(ABBY steps forward to address audience.)* **We’re glad you could join us for the day. I’d like you to meet everyone! This is Alex. He’s a terrific soccer player and a great team player.**

ALEX: *(to audience)* **Here at *Follow U*, I’m learning to follow God’s playbook.**

STUART: **And we all want to play to the best of our abilities for God!**

BEN: *(turns to JERRY)* **Quick quiz! Definition of a minion.**

JERRY: **Minion – a follower or underling of a powerful person. Minion!**

ABBY: **And this is Benjamin and Jeremiah, but we call them Ben and Jerry. They are really smart. They’ve always got the answers... if you can understand what they are saying.**

BEN: **We probably should not converse at the present time. It is imperative that we are punctual!**

MONA: *(explaining to audience)* **That means we don’t want to be late. *(turns to Ben)* Right, Ben?**

BEN: **Precisely, Mona.**

ABBY: **Thanks, Mona. These are my best friends, Mona and Stacy.**

MONA and STACY: **Hi!**

ABBY: **We all write for our school paper. Stacy writes the music reviews, Alex writes sports, Mona edits and Ben does everything technical. I write the advice column.**

PRINCIPAL ABLE: **Hello, Abby. Better get going. Got a great day ahead of you!** *(He exits)*

ABBY: (to audience) **That was Principal Able.**

MONA: **Oh, that reminds me, Abby.** *(She takes a letter from her pocket.)* **You got a letter.**

ABBY: **Thanks, Mona.**

STACY: **Who was it from?**

ABBY: **I'm not sure. It's just signed, "Anonymous."**

ALEX: **What did it say, Abby?**

ABBY: *(takes out the letter and reads)*

Dear Abigail. I don't know what to do. My mom just lost her job. Since my dad's been gone, I've tried hard to help. I deliver newspapers in the morning and help with my brother and sister. I want to be a good example because my family doesn't know Jesus. I keep praying, but I don't think it's making any difference. Maybe I don't belong here.

Signed, Anonymous.

(puts the letter down)

STUART: **I think JJ wrote this letter.**

MONA: **Maybe you should go talk to Principal Able.**

KEVIN: **Maybe we should pray.**

ABBY: **You're right. That's the first thing we should do.**

MONA: **I'll pray, Abby.**

CD #17: Drama Scene 2 – The Classroom

PROP NEEDS: 5 pocket folders, one for each student (can be different colors)
 with *Follow U* logo on front
 5 “homework” papers for student to turn in
 5 Bibles
 Clipboard and class roll for the Professor
 Hand mirror for the professor
 Flashlight for the professor
 Headlamp for the professor

ABBY: *(to audience)* **Welcome! Our teacher is Professor Isaac Noah Why. But we just call him Professor Noah. He’s a little forgetful, but we love him. Oh! Here he is now.**

(ABBY goes to her seat. PROFESSOR NOAH enters. He has a flashlight hanging from belt, a headlamp, and he is holding a pocket mirror. He sets everything down on a table.)

PROFESSOR: *(mumbling to himself as he walks in)* **All right, now where did I put my lamp. Oh, it’s on my head. *(takes off the headlamp)* There, that’s much better. I feel *lighter* now. Good morning, class!**

KIDS: **Good morning, Professor.**

PROFESSOR: **Are we all here? *(He counts)* I think we may be missing someone.**

ALEX: **That would be JJ.**

PROFESSOR: **Hmm... Well we’ll just have to get started without him, *(with excitement)* I don’t want to waste a minute of time. I’ve got some wonderful things to show you!**

STACY: **Professor Noah, should we pass in our homework?**

PROFESSOR: *(puzzled)* **What? Oh yes. Thank you, Tracy.**

STACY: **Uh, it’s Stacy, sir.**

PROFESSOR: *(absentmindedly)* **Yes, of course it is. Now, where was I? *(He remembers)* Did you do your homework, class?**

TIM: **We just passed it in.**

PROFESSOR: *(delighted)* **Well, why didn't you say so? Before we get into our lesson, can anyone tell me what we were working on yesterday?**

STUART: *(nervously)* **Don't you remember, Professor?**

PROFESSOR: *(impatiently)* **Certainly I do! I just want to know if *you* do.**

DAVE: **I do! Our lesson was from Psalm 57, verses 9-11. "I will praise you, O Lord, among the nations; I will sing of you among the peoples. For great is your love, reaching to the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let your glory be over all the earth." (NIV)**

STACY: **God's love is so great that nothing can separate us from it. Knowing a love that great makes us want to praise Him and tell the whole world about Him!**

MARK: **Matthew 5:16 says, "Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." (NIV)**

ALEX: **So, when I learn to reflect God's love in everything, whether it's at home or at school or on the soccer field, I honor Him and give Him glory.**

PROFESSOR: **Correct!**

(JJ enters. She is embarrassed to be late.)

PROFESSOR: **Well, hello. You must be my missing student! Take a seat. (He looks over his attendance sheet) Hmm... what is your name?**

JJ: **It's JJ, sir.**

PROFESSOR: **Ah, yes, here it is. Take a seat, and please see Principal Able after class.**

(JJ goes quickly to his seat.)

PROFESSOR: *(absentmindedly)* **Now, where was I? (He remembers) Oh yes. Benjamin, can you give me the definition of reflection?**

BEN: **The law of reflection is the principle that when light is reflected from a smooth surface the angle of reflection is equal to the angle of incidence. Both of these...**

CLASS: *(moaning: cutting him off mid-sentence at his scientific explanation.)*

BEN: **Well, you asked.**

PROFESSOR: **Perhaps someone else could explain.**

MONA: *(raises her hand)*

PROFESSOR: **Yes, Monica.**

MONA: **It's Mona, professor. A reflection is a mirror image of something. When you position the mirror correctly you see an exact image of the object.**

MARK: **When we stay focused on Jesus, we become more like Him!**

PROFESSOR: **Correct! For example, I can see my reflection when I look in this mirror.** *(sees himself in the mirror)* **Oh dear.** *(quickly sets the mirror down)* **Let's just review our next verse.**

TIM: *(raises his hand)*

TIM: **Colossians 1:15 says, "Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation." (NLT)**

PROFESSOR: **God's plan, from the very beginning, is that through His Son we would get to know His love. Christ reflects the Father's love and He asks that we do the same to others. We are to be about His work here on earth. Minions that reflect the love of the most supreme being.**

(Music begins to "Glory to God Forever")

CD #19: Drama Scene 3 – Principal Able’s Office

PROP NEEDS: Items for the desk: pencil cup, Bible, books, stack of paper/folders
Small desktop Christian flag
Name plate with “Principal Able” on it
Pen and paper
Paper slips for the “excused tardy” note

(PRINCIPAL ABLE enters and sits at desk. JJ approaches his office.)

JJ: **Principal Able, are you busy?**
PRINCIPAL: *(looking up)* **Hello, JJ. What can I do for you?**
JJ: **Professor Noah said to come and see you.**
PRINCIPAL: **Late again?**
JJ: *(nods)*
PRINCIPAL: **Is everything okay at home?**
JJ: **Yeah... just some more things came up.**

PRINCIPAL: **Do you want to talk about it?**

JJ: **Not right now.**

PRINCIPAL: *(writes a slip and hands it to him)* **Well, here you go. You're excused JJ.**

JJ: **I'll make up everything I missed, I promise.**

PRINCIPAL: **I know you will. You're one of our best students.**

JJ: *(starts to leave, but turns around)* **Principal Able.**

PRINCIPAL: **Yes?**

JJ: **Do you think God always hears us when we pray?**

PRINCIPAL: **Always. Why do you ask?**

JJ: **I've got to decide something. I've been asking God what to do. But I haven't gotten any answer yet.**

PRINCIPAL: *(goes over to JJ)* **He hears you. You said you don't have an answer yet. Keep praying, JJ, and don't give up. Your heavenly Father knows just what you need, and when you need it. He knows your name and every hair on your head. You're important to Him. Do you know why?**

JJ: **Why?**

PRINCIPAL: **Because you're His child. (PRINCIPAL exits.)**

(music begins to "Who Am I?")

(Dancers Enter)

CD #21: Drama Scene 4 – The Classroom

PROP NEEDS: Light sticks (one for the Professor, one for Principal Able, one for each student)
Students should have their folders and Bibles as in Scene Two

(PROFESSOR NOAH gets out light sticks.)

PROFESSOR: *(Enthusiastically)* **Okay, class! For the last part of our lesson today, I want to illustrate one of my favorite subjects – light! Can you tell me what this light stick is for?**

STACY: **To see when it's dark?**

PROFESSOR: **Yes. When they glow they're quite useful. But this light stick won't glow unless I bend it. *(He bends the light stick)* Bending it causes one solution to flow into the other. When they combine, they form a brand new solution. Then they glow as they were made to! So, what can we learn here?**

JERRY: **God's life flowing into us through the life of His Son is what makes us shine!**

PROFESSOR: **You are correct! We were all made to shine. And that light in your life will help others find their way when life looks dark.**

EVERYONE: *(all greet JJ and ABBY, as they enter.)*

JJ: **Sorry we're late, Professor.**

ABBY: **Sorry we're both late.**

PROFESSOR: **Ah well, you're just in time for the last bell.**

(Bell Rings SFX)

PROFESSOR: **Class dismissed! *(He exits.)***

STUART: **So Abby was right. That letter was from you, wasn't it, JJ?**

JJ: **Yeah, it was.**

MONA: **What happened? Is everything all right?**

ABBY: **When I went to Principal Able's office, JJ was already there.**

JJ: ~~I finally decided to tell him what was going on. After we talked, he wanted to call my mom. He asked her to come to school.~~

ABBY: *(excitedly)* **Principal Able asked JJ's mom to come to work here!**

KEVIN: **That's awesome. We prayed for you, JJ. We knew God would work it all out.**

JJ: **But that's not the best part. I realized I needed to talk to my mom, too. So I told her about all the great things I've learned here... about how great God's love is... about how I've learned to see His hand in everything around me... about how He loves us all so much that He sent Jesus. I told her that she was so important to Jesus that He gave His life just for her. Then I asked her if I could pray with her. You know what the best news is? My mom gave her life to Jesus!**

EVERYONE: *(ad lib cheering)* **Awesome! That is so great! Etc.**

ABBY: *(to JJ)* **JJ, all of the times you were late, I thought it was just because you didn't care about *anything*. But you've been the best example of what Jesus tells us to do. You kept praying, and you were willing to do whatever you needed for your family. Will you forgive me?**

JJ: **Sure, Abby.**

DAVE: **Listen up, everyone, I've got an idea. We still need the lead article for the next issue. I think JJ should write it and tell her story. It would help other kids who might be going through hard things, too.**

EVERYONE: *(ad lib)* **Great idea... Yea... That's perfect...**

JJ: **I'd like that!**

BEN & JERRY: **That would be propitious!**

PRINCIPAL ABLE: **I brought one of Professor Noah's light sticks. There's something that I'd like to show you.**
(He holds up the light stick.)

PRINCIPAL ABLE:

This light stick has to be broken before it starts to shine. Just like Jesus had to go to the cross to fulfill God's plan for us and become our Savior. Sometimes life can be tough. But it's during those times that we can shine brighter. You never stop doing what God tells you to do. You pray, and believe, and continue to trust Him even when it's hard. And you will make a difference to everyone around you.

JJ:

Thanks, Principal Able.

JERRY:

We're glad you're gonna *stick* around, JJ.

JJ:

I'm going to stick with Jesus! The power of His love in my life helped my whole family. I'm going to trust Him, and believe He hears me. God never forgets anyone!

(music begins to "Not Forgotten")
