-**Triune**: three in one in perfect unity – “tri-unity”.

The Trinity is $1 \times 1 \times 1 = 1$ and $1 + 1 + 1 = 3$. (*Genesis 1:26, Isaiah 6:8, Matt. 28:19, Ephesians 4:4-6, 1 Peter 1:1-2, Jude 20-21*)

-**Theology**: the study of God, the nature of the divine, and the specifics of religious thought.

-**Christology**: the study of the person & work of Jesus.

-**Pneumatology**: the study of the person, work, and gifts of the Holy Spirit.
