Jazz: Benefit for Billy Shiell

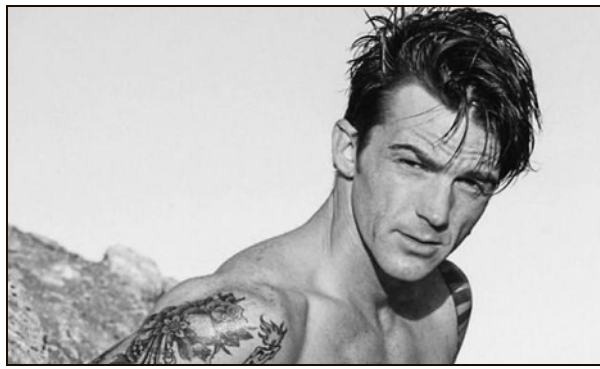


Sunday: Trumpeter and composer Billy Shiell has been one of the stalwarts of the Twin Cities jazz scene since relocating here in the 1970s. Previously, he had gigged on the East Coast and been a member of a touring Canadian Big Band called Illustration. In the '80s, he had a stint with Twin Cities blues-rockers the Lamont Cranston Band. In recent years, he's been less active due to health problems. Sunday afternoon at Jazz Central in Minneapolis, some of Shiell's jazz colleagues are honoring him with a benefit and jam. Musicians performing will include the duo of guitarist Dean Magraw and percussionist Marcus Wise (pictured above); drummer Mac Santiago and his trio, which features bassist Billy Peterson and pianist Phil Aaron; multi-instrumentalist Steve Kimmel, and others. **2 p.m.; Jazz Central Studios, 407 Central Ave., Mpls.; suggested donation; 612-729-1799 or jazzcentralstudios.org.**

Pop: Drake Bell



Wednesday: At his father's urging, Drake Bell began his acting career at the age of 5 and found work in commercials as well as bit roles on "Home Improvement," "Seinfeld" and the film "Jerry Maguire." His career really took off in the early '00s when he starred in the Nickelodeon hits "The Amanda Show" and "Drake and Josh." He played a musician on television so it only made sense Bell would pursue music on the side and issued his debut album, "Telegraph," in 2005. On it, he performed the same sort of Beatles-inspired power pop the Jonas Brothers were dabbling in at the time, although Bell never managed to reach as many fans. Former Stray Cat and current Minneapolis resident Brian Setzer served as executive producer for Bell's most recent full-length, "Ready Steady Go!," which includes covers of the Kinks, Queen and, yup, the Stray Cats. **7 p.m.; Cabooze, 917 Cedar Ave. S., Mpls.; \$100-\$20; 612-338-6425 or cabooze.com.**

Country: Kathy Mattea



Thursday: West Virginia native Kathy Mattea began her recording career in 1984 and, soon after, scored a string of chart-topping country hits, including "Goin' Gone," "Eighteen Wheels and a Dozen Roses," "Come from the Heart" and "Burnin' Old Memories." From there, Mattea expanded her scope, traveling to Scotland and exploring the links between American country music and traditional Scottish folk. When she entered her 50s earlier this decade, she struggled with changes to her voice which led to an extended "dark night of the soul" as she figured out a way to continue singing. Jazz: Paris Combo

Tuesday-Wednesday: Over the course of two decades and six albums, the Paris Combo has developed an international following with its blend of French Cabaret music, Gypsy jazz and French pop music. Fronted by vocalist Belle du Berry, the Combo has been a big draw at major jazz festivals and venues, since the gold-selling success of their 2000 album "Living Room." Last year they released an album of reconfigured material, "Paris Combo, Remixed," and are working on a new album of original material. Rock: William Fitzsimmons



Tuesday: Singer/songwriter William Fitzsimmons was born to blind parents who pursued music as a hobby and encouraged their son to do so, as well. He grew up playing a fully functioning pipe organ his father built and went on to learn trombone and any number of stringed instruments, from guitar to banjo. But before going into music himself, Fitzsimmons earned a master's degree in counseling and worked as a mental health therapist. He began releasing home recordings and built a following in part through placing his songs on TV shows like "Grey's Anatomy," "Blue Bloods" and "Army Wives." Fitzsimmons has always drawn on his personal life for inspiration, and his latest album "Mission Bell" follows a painful separation from his second wife.
