

Alfred Packer was a man made infamous by his peculiar crime; cannibalism. The fact Packer had murdered and eaten five hunting companions during a Colorado blizzard in 1873 was horrifying. Hardly anyone could think of a worse crime,

well except for one person. The judge at the trial M. B. Gerry was quoted to have said to Packer at his sentencing, "There were seven Democrats in Hinsdale County, but you ate five of them. I sentence you to be hanged by the neck until you're dead, dead, dead, as a warning against reducing the Democratic population of the state."
