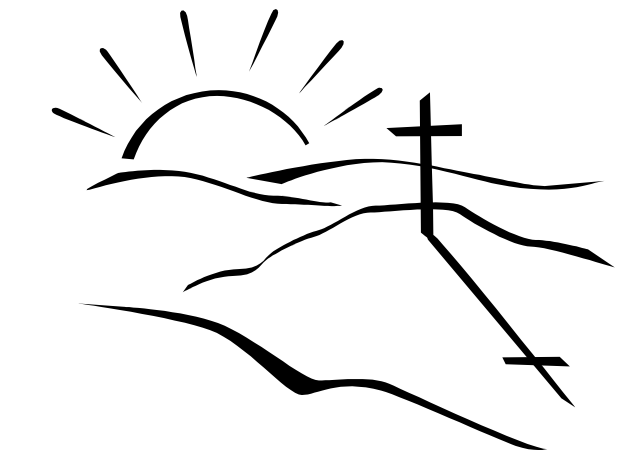

The Christian Family

I was reading a book the other day and it was talking about the first century church from Acts. Acts 2:42, “They were continually devoting themselves to the apostle’ teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Acts 2:44,45, “And all those who had believed were together and had all things in common; and they began selling their property and possessions and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need.” It is good to have those in Christ that share the same values, beliefs, and vision. Those who share the name “Christian.”

The scripture gives the idea that these people depended on each other to live their lives. The most important thing in their lives was being in fellowship with one and other and Jesus Christ. Luke used wonderful words in this passage that bring excitement and warmth to our heart, “all those who had believed were together and had all things in common.” In our day and age when we are very busy people and getting busier every day, it is good to focus on our Lord and Savior.

The early church did more than make converts; they also made disciples. The church was unified, magnified, and multiplied. The Christians you meet in the book of Acts were not content to meet once a week for “services as usual.” They met daily, cared daily, won souls daily, searched the Scripture daily, and increased in number daily. Their Christian faith was a day-to-day reality! The church is the family of God, and we have this great example to follow.
