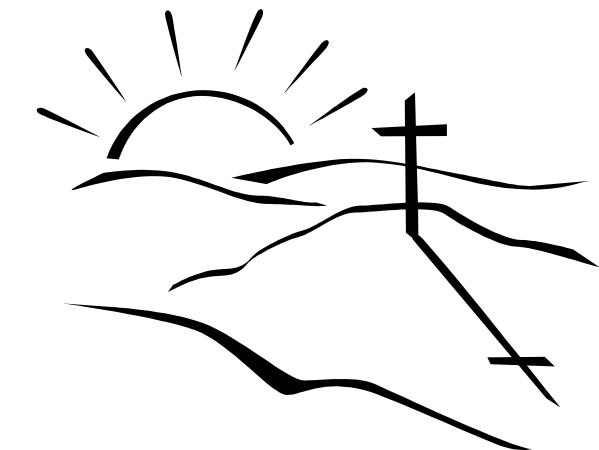

The Example of Acts Two

In the church each and every member means so much! When we come together on a Sunday morning, we often look around the room to see our friends, family and brothers and sisters in Christ. It does not take too long to notice the ones that are missing. We may text, message on social media or even call the missing person. Sometimes we may think that the same people miss over and over again so why bother them by sending them a message. But we want them to know that they are part of the church, and they are truly missed and are a vital part of the church family.

One of the best examples of the church is in Acts 2:42, *“They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles’ teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.”* They were devoted to the apostles teaching and to the brethren who had believed in Jesus Christ. We know that there were thousands of them, and they still had the excitement of salvation. Because of the excitement of their belief in Jesus, they dedicated themselves to the teachings and the brethren.

When we continue to look at the early church relationship, we see that the group was very tight and loving. It looks like the perfect plan set in place by God and the apostles to make the church grow. As Christians we have that type of relationship with each other. It is a different type of relationship than that of the world. We are all followers of Jesus Christ!
