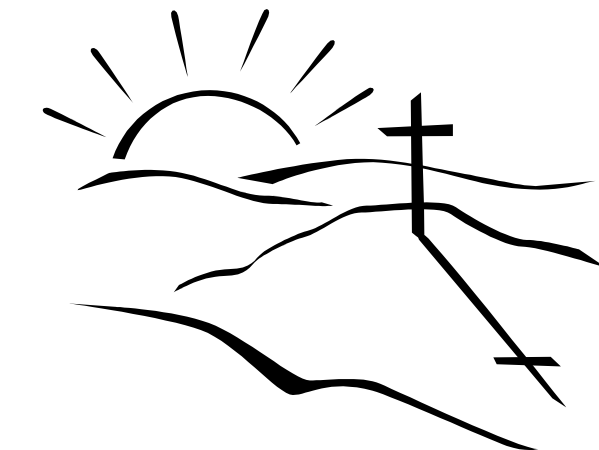

We need some good news!

We live in a world where we can all use some good news! For a matter of fact, we could use some great news. When you look at the news it all seems bad. Prices are at a record high, the stock market is down from where it was, the political world is in an uproar. People in general seem less happy than they have ever been. We are very good at finding things wrong all around us. I often think, what would have happened if sin never entered the world? Everything would be perfect! But we all know that sin did enter the world and we see it around us every day.

But, there is good news for all of us! Exciting news! News that can and will change our lives. The gospel of Jesus Christ our Lord. He came to this world and died on the cross to save us from sin. The term “gospel” translates the Greek word (*euangelion*), which means “good news.” Euangelion was used in the ancient world in context of joyful announcements, including the birth of a child, the coming of a king, victory in war, and a wedding feast. Significantly, all of these usages have their parallel in Jesus’ life.

Sometimes we get so busy in life that we forget to tell others about the good news of Jesus Christ. If we are part of the Lord’s church and we are part of God’s family we have heard and obeyed the gospel of Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 1:8 (ESV) *“in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.”* People need to hear the good news of Jesus because they will be punished eternally if they do not obey. Let us put time and great effort into sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ, the good news. We can all us some good news!

We all have gone straight to the "Help Wanted" column of the classified section of the newspaper. When I needed a second or third job, I would spend a dollar in hopes of finding employment in the Sunday edition. Most of the time, we can find work if we are seeking. This is especially true in the work of the church.

Someone once told me, "There should never be any unemployed Christians." Much work is to be done in bringing others to Christ. We know secular work sustains our family and allows the work of the church to grow. However, we are still expected to work for the Lord by sowing and reaping.
