

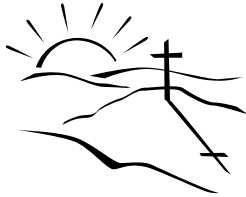

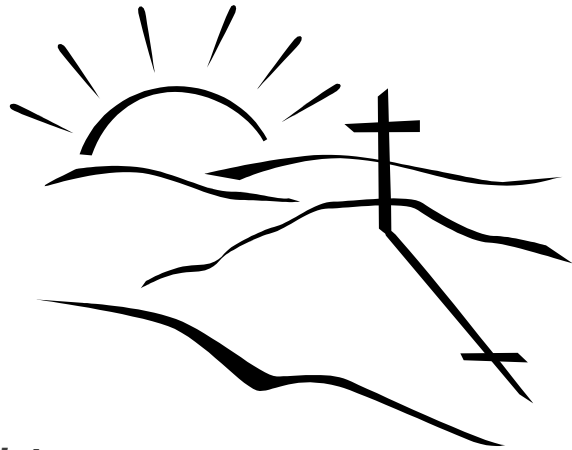

What about Worship!

Facebook must know my algorithm! When scanning through Facebook it started to bring up different worship services. It must notice that I pay attention to different congregations' streams. Not only did it bring up different congregations of the church of Christ, but it brought up services from the denominational world. When scanning through a couple of denominational services they seemed very entertaining. With both services the goal seemed to be to get the audience excited and entertain them. Once they

were both excited and entertained it was time for the offering.

We know that the central purpose of any congregation of God's people is to publicly gather to offer worship and praise to the living and true God. Our highest concern must be that our worship be acceptable and pleasing to God. The history of God's people, both in the biblical record and since the time of Christ, has shown that there is no area of the church's life which is more prone to corruption than its worship.

The Bible makes it clear that God has not left His worship open to the inventions and devices of men. God alone has the prerogative to determine how He should be worshiped. The Bible tells us in several passages about worship. Leviticus 10:1-2 (ESV) ¹ Now Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, each took his censer and put fire in it and laid incense on it and offered unauthorized fire before the LORD, which he had not commanded them. ² And fire came out from before the LORD and consumed them, and they died before the LORD.

When we come to worship it is for the purpose of worshiping our God. We need to search the scripture to see what is good and acceptable to our God. We come together to worship and praise God not to entertain and excite the congregation. The famous words to the song, "Oh Worship the King all Glorious Above!" Let us look to scripture to learn how to worship our God. Our God wants to be worshipped and He lets us know how.

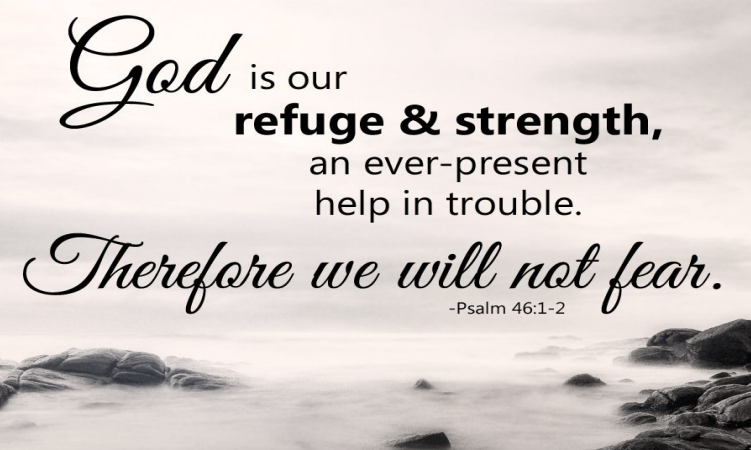


- † Please remember Kim Fought, Sandy Bungard’s brother in your prayers.
