Angels



Many times, when someone passes away, we say that they become an angel. Although that is a very nice thought it probably is far from the truth. When we study the Bible, we notice a few things. First of all we must emphasize that angels are creatures, constituting the main part of the “invisible” creation of Col 1:16. Psalm 148:1-4 exhorts angels and other creatures: “Praise Him, all His angels; Praise Him, all His hosts!” then verse 5 adds, “Let them praise the name of the Lord, for He commanded and they were created.”

Since they are created beings, angels are finite in every way; in no sense do they share God’s infinity. They are limited with regard to space, time, knowledge, and power. Their knowledge and power are superior to that of human beings, but they are neither omniscient nor omnipotent.

A major implication of the fact that angels are created beings is that under no circumstances are we to put them on the same level as God. It is wrong to worship them in any sense (Rev. 19:10; 22:8-9). Also, it is important to remember that Satan, a fallen created angel, is not an evil divine being who is independent from God and God’s eternal antagonist in a kind of dualistic universe. Like every other creature, Satan is a finite being and is under the complete sovereign rule of God.

Because they are spirit, angels are personal beings capable of personal interaction with both God (Job 1, 2) and man (Mark 16:5-7; Luke 1:26-38; Rev. 22:8-9). As persons they have minds (Eph. 3:10; 1 Pet. 1:12; Jude 9), and they are moral beings with a knowledge of good and evil and the free will to choose between them. Having the ability to sin, some angels did so (John 8:44; 2 Pet. 2:4; 1 John 3:8), but the rest remained holy (Deut. 33:2; Ps. 89:5-7; Mark 8:30; Rev. 14:10). It is usually assumed that fallen angels were given no chance to repent, and that the holy angels are no longer able to sin.

Some questions we ask: why did God create angels? What are their functions within the created orders? The Bible summed up the answers in Psalms 130:20-21, “Bless the Lord, you His angels, mighty in strength, who perform His word, obeying the voice of His word! Bless the Lord, all you His hosts, you who serve Him, doing His will.” In other words, they exist to carry out God’s orders. Angles are a blessing to God and a blessing to Christians.
