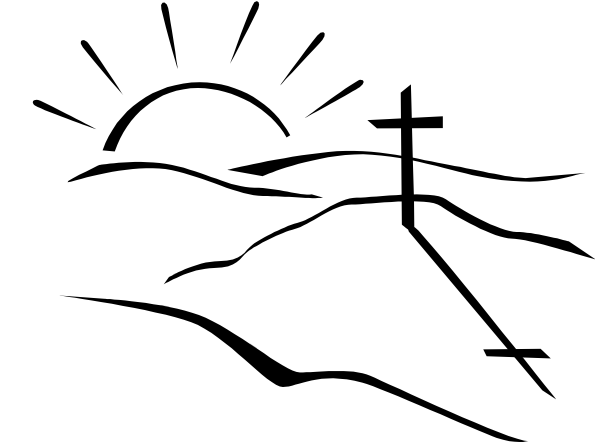


Giving to the Needy

As the holiday season quickly approaches many will consider giving something to the needy to help during a giving season. There are many different good organizations that you can choose to give to that will help those in need. But does the Christian have any responsibility to the needy? When we look to the Word of God, we see many examples of the needy. Jesus seems to always be with people that were in need. The Bible says in Matthew 14:13, "When he went ashore he saw a great crowd, and he had compassion on them and healed their sick." The Greek word for "compassion" used here is (*splagchnizomai*) and means to feel sympathy, to pity, to be moved with compassion. The idea is to be moved to do something about the situation. In this case Jesus was moved with compassion to make sure that everyone was fed and even had food to take home.

Another good example of giving in the Bible is found in Acts 2:44-45, "And all who believed were together and had all things in common. And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need." This must have been something to see a group of people selling things then giving the money to those who had traveled to Jerusalem. Ordinarily, they were only going to be in Jerusalem for a few days but because of the gospel of Jesus many stayed longer. This behavior of those that had compassion made it possible for many to hear the gospel and become Christians.

The apostle Paul wrote in Galatians 6:9-10, "And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith." The message that the Bible seems to have for us is that it is important to have compassion on others. No matter what the season or time of the year Christians should not get tired or grow weary of doing good. We all could agree that if Jesus walked on the earth today with us, he would defiantly do good to people he came in contact with daily. We need to follow Jesus and have compassion on others. They could be the answer to sharing the good news of Jesus Christ.
