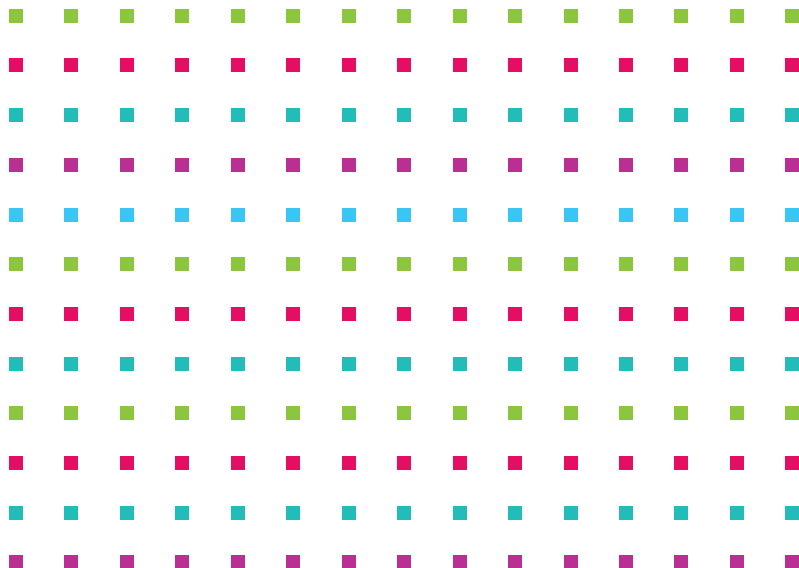

Green design

Noteworthy design

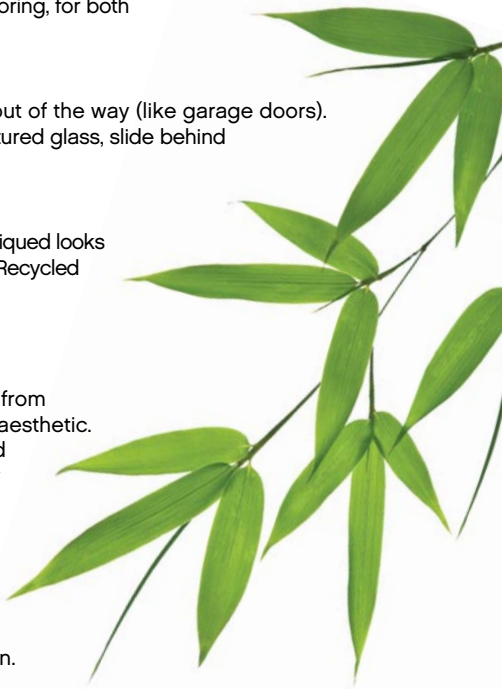

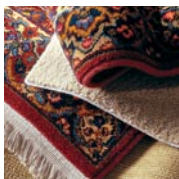


Freshen a color scheme quickly with inexpensive accessories — towels, rugs, oven mitts and table linens.

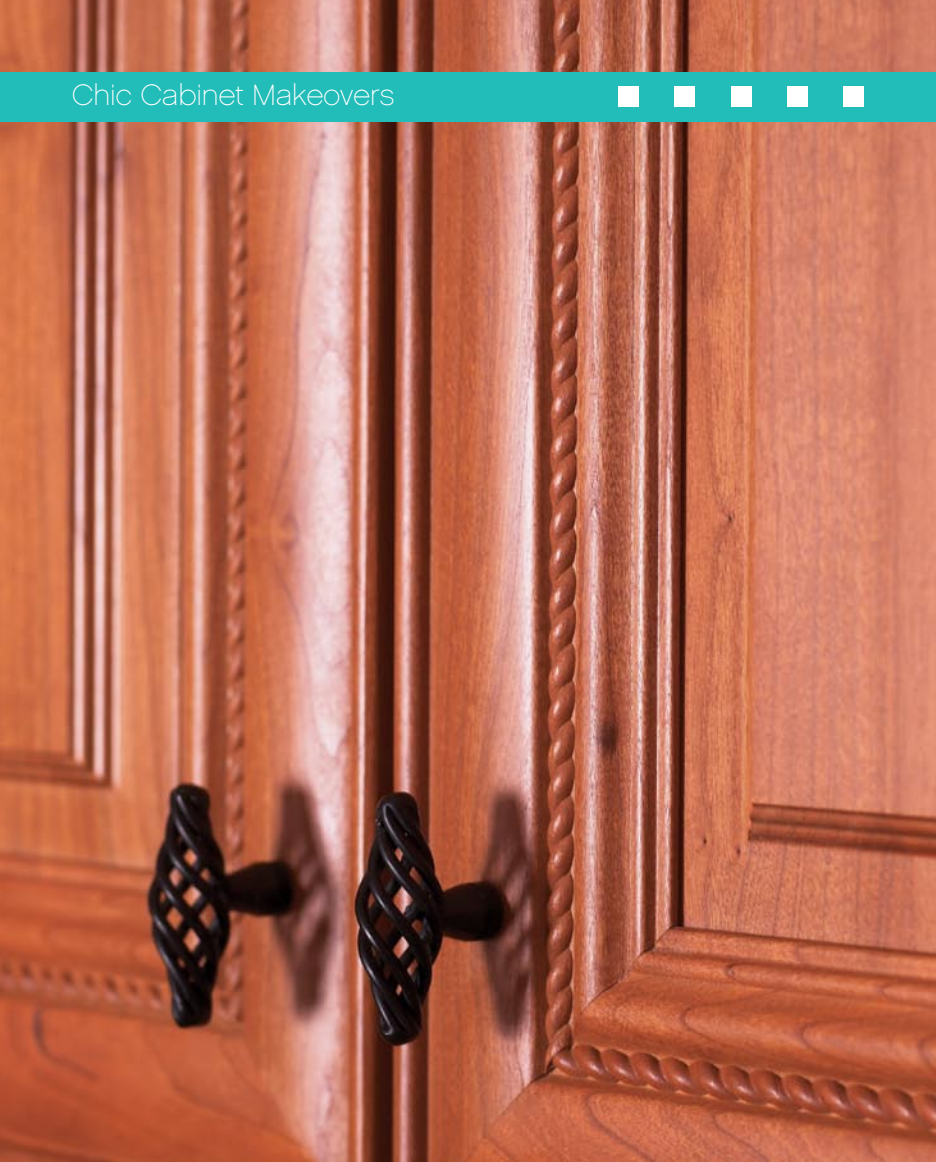

Chic Cabinet Makeovers



Add character with new knobs and pulls. There are thousands of options!



Remove upper cabinets and replace with open shelves or hanging plate racks.

Use colorful café curtains to replace any cabinet door in the kitchen.

Place cork panels or opaque white glass into the centers of framed cabinet doors.

Install molding above the tops of cabinets or add trim to cabinet fronts.

How-To | Get a fresh new look — paint your cabinets

- 1 Empty cabinets and clear off countertops.
- 2 Remove doors and drawer fronts; number them so you can replace them correctly.
- 3 Set up worktables or use the basement or garage floor for painting doors and drawers.
- 4 Mask off the walls around the cabinet frames.
- 5 Clean surfaces thoroughly, rinse with water and let dry.
- 6 Test a small area with primer, then paint to be sure they adhere properly.
- 7 Fill in drill holes left by old hardware if you plan to use new knobs with different hole spacing.
- 8 Use sandpaper to dull the existing finish; remove dust with a wet rag or vacuum.
- 9 Use primer to prepare the surface for paint and fill in small imperfections.
- 10 Use a brush or roller to apply at least two coats of paint; let each coat dry thoroughly.

Backsplashes

Small project, big impact. A new backsplash instantly invigorates your kitchen. Create contrast (matte white tile with polished black granite countertop) or develop a style theme (brightly patterned Mexican tile with sealed hardwood top). Or simply add color and shine!

Tile options range from mass-produced 1" x 1" squares to custom colors and mosaic murals. New trends: bamboo tiles; cork; cool metals; honed granite. Or, try chalkboard paint!



Lighting

Create the right light. A well-lit room needs several light sources for balance: recessed, surface, decorative and task lights. Halogen gives the best color rendition and sparkle; it's popular for in-cabinet lights and island pendants.

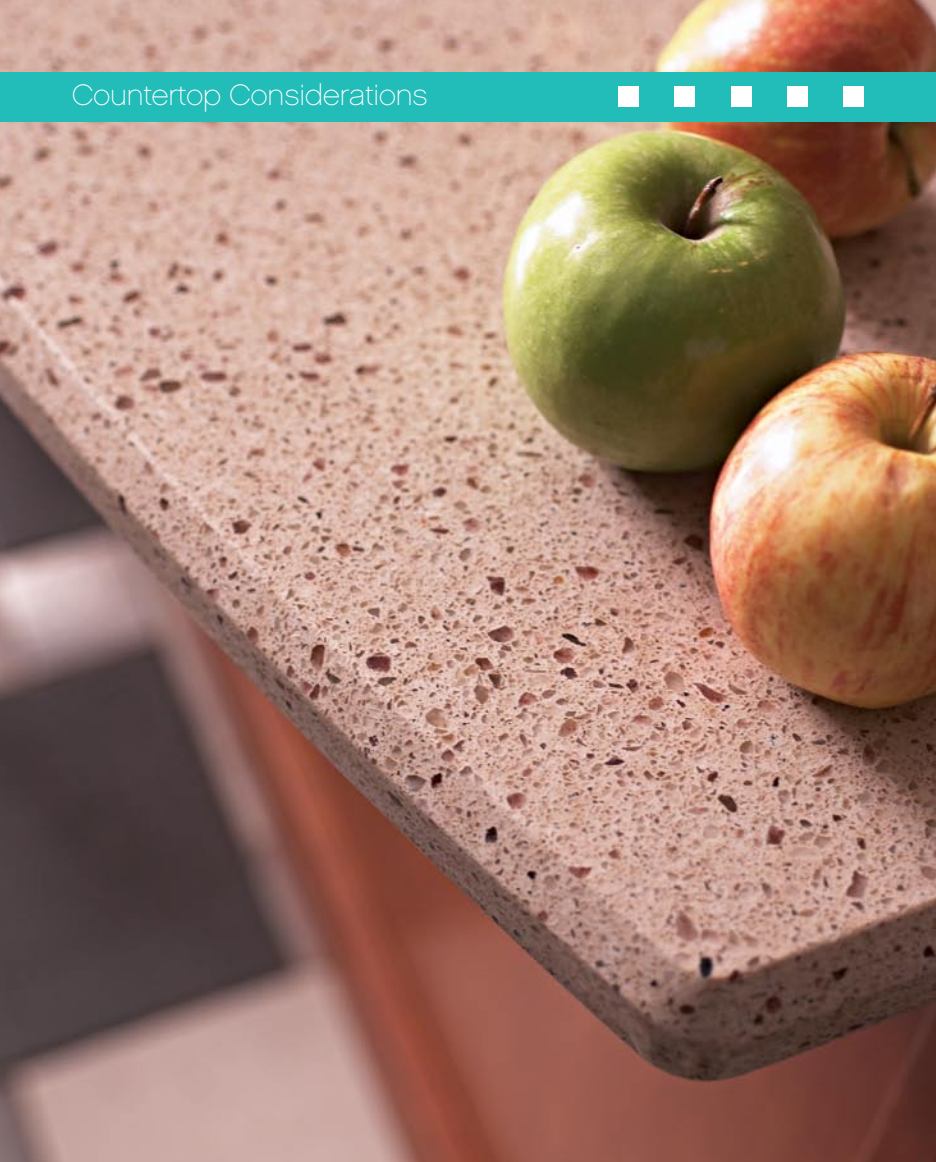
Need task lighting? Add undercabinet halogen strips or battery-operated lights. Craving a new look? Switch out a recessed can for a decorative pendant; try two over an island or sink. Dimmer switches instantly change the mood. Call your electrician for assistance.



Faucets

Quick fix for real function. Switching out an old kitchen faucet for a new model adds value and function. Replace a standard faucet with a pullout spray; many models offer two or more spray options and a "pause" button.

Commercial style pot-filler faucets have a high "gooseneck" arc that lets you fill tall stockpots easily. You can even find wall-mount gooseneck faucets that install on the backsplash. Unless you or your partner are an expert, always call a plumbing professional to install your new fixture.



Countertop Considerations



Two big trends: the preference for natural-looking materials and mixing and matching surfaces. Both open up exciting design possibilities.

Laminate

Durable, versatile and affordable, laminate is a sensible choice. It's easy to clean with soap and water but vulnerable to sharp knives and hot pans. Thousands of color and pattern options are available.

Ceramic tile

Durable ceramic offers distinctive design at a reasonable price. Vitreous ceramic is dense enough to withstand hot-off-the-fire pots so it's a good option next to a range. Tile grout cleans up with a sponge but is prone to staining.

Natural stone

Tough and beautiful, granite is popular and now more affordable. It endures hot pans, knives and most stains (except oily ones). Marble has similar qualities, but is more porous and stains easily. Both surfaces require periodic sealing.

Solid surfacing

More resistant to scratches than laminate and less likely to stain than marble, solid surfacing, which requires no sealing, resembles stone and can be cut and shaped. Sinks and countertops can be integrated for a seamless look. Choices range from stone patterns to vivid solids.

Stainless steel

This ultra-contemporary look appeals to cooks who want to match commercial-style appliances. Pricy stainless is durable, won't melt or scorch and is sanitary but scratches easily. If you want a pristine look, the patina that develops from constant use may not be for you.

Things to Consider

Cleanability

For easy care, choose vinyl, laminate or ceramic tile. Other options require more upkeep.

Durability

Ceramic, stone, laminate and concrete rank at the top for standing up to kids and pets.

Longevity

Stone and ceramic tile, hardwood, cork and concrete stand the test of time.

Moisture resistance

Tile, vinyl and certain types of laminate (check manufacturers' warranties) are more water-resistant.

Allergens

If you're concerned about indoor air quality, choose hard flooring like ceramic or wood that has fewer crevices to harbor dust mites and allergens.

Hardwood

Hardwood lasts longer than other options and can be refinished or restained. Polyurethane coatings allow installation in kitchens and baths, as long as you minimize water spills.

Ceramic and stone

Durable and low-maintenance, ceramic and stone come in unlimited colors, patterns and sizes. Granite is practically indestructible; softer stone like marble may contain imperfections that diminish performance.

Laminate

Laminate flooring is a decorative image printed on one or more thin sheets of paper, impregnated with resin, bonded to a rigid core and backed to prevent warping. It typically costs less than hardwood.

Cork

Cork is 100% renewable, resilient, naturally hypoallergenic and as durable as hardwood yet provides cushioning. It cuts easily to create patterns, and now comes in colors beyond brown tones.

Kitchen Layouts



Be sure form follows function: the way you prepare, cook and clean up should drive your layout decisions. Picture yourself carrying in groceries (where will they land?) or laying out baking supplies (are they stored together near the oven?). Aim for a smooth progression of tasks.

Allow at least 15 in. of landing area on the handle side of the refrigerator, or 15 in. on both sides of a side-by-side.

Plan for countertop workspace of at least 36 in. next to the sink.

Plan for a minimum 12 – 15 in. landing area on both sides of the cooking surface.

Allow a 15 in. landing area next to or above the oven.

The cook's work aisle should be at least 42 in. Two cooks require at least 48 in.

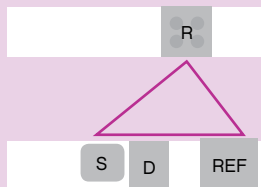
Guidelines to kitchen efficiency

The work triangle is composed of imaginary lines drawn from the sink to the cooktop to the refrigerator and back to the sink. The sum of the lines should be no more than 26 feet.

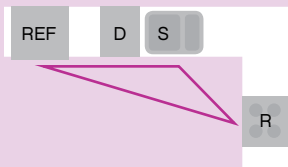

Classic kitchen layouts

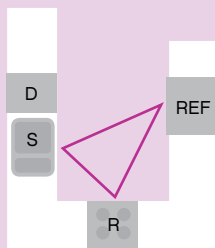
