Our tests showed steam cleaners couldn't shift baked-on oven grime, so how do you clean yours? Share your secrets and help shape our testing. Go to www.which.co.uk/grime



Portable steam cleaners are light and easy to carry, but do they clean well? To find out, we tested how they tackled a variety of stains, compared with elbow grease and a Best Buy cleaning product (or highest-scoring product from previous tests).

Portable steam cleaners look like handheld vacuum cleaners with a water tank. There's a nozzle to direct steam to loosen dirt, and many can be used with attachments such as hoses, brushes or upholstery tools to make it easier to steam a range of surfaces. We tested them on scummy tiles, grubby glass, stained upholstery and baked-on oven grime.

#### **OUR TESTS**

We recorded how well steam cleaners cleaned, plus how long and how much effort this took using the most suitable attachment provided or available to buy. Traditional products cleaned best in all our tests, but usually needed more effort and took longer. Steam cleaners were best at refreshing fabrics. Tiles/grout Best Buy multi-purpose cleaner Cif Actifizz (£2.75, 750ml) removed more soap scum and grime. Tiles looked shinier.

Red wine Vanish Oxi Action Power Carpet and Upholstery Spray (£4.60, 500ml) almost completely removed a red wine stain from

upholstery, but steam cleaners often left fabric soggy and the stain still obvious. Glass Glass covered with layers of dried-on oily film was less streaky after cleaning with Windowlene Original (£2.50, 500ml) than a steam cleaner and squeegee attachment. Oven grime No handheld steam cleaner made a dent on baked-on oven grime, but one application of Best Buy Lakeland Oven Mate (£8.49, 500ml) produced great results. **Refresh fabrics** A win for steam cleaners. We lined a dog's bed with a piece of calico curtain for a week and tested to check if creases and dog smell were removed by steaming. Steam cleaners did better than a Best Buy iron with vertical steaming function. Most reduced smell and were great on creases. But some made the fabric too wet to get rid of either.

#### **OUR VERDICT**

The hassle of refilling steam cleaners means a chemical cleaning product is generally better. We weren't convinced handheld steam models have the capacity to make cleaning super quick, or the power to shift tough grime.

A steam cleaner generally shifts grime more quickly than cleaning by hand. But most handheld models only give seven to eight minutes of steam at a time and you should let them cool for five minutes before refilling. If cleaning takes longer, you may spend as much time waiting to refill and reheat the tank as you'd gain by using a steamer. A good one, such as the Best Buy Thane, may add power to elbow grease but many are unimpressive.

BEST

#### Thane Housewares H20 Mop X5 £100

#### Which? test score 66%

PROS This is mainly a steam mop (which was close to being a Best Buy in our steam mop test) but it can be converted into a handheld steam cleaner by removing the mop handle. It comes with attachments including an extension hose, window cleaning and garment steaming tools that are easy to attach. It's good for

cleaning glass; minor streaks just need wiping down afterwards. It's also good at removing smells and creases from fabric. It takes just 21 seconds to heat, and produces a lot of steam. The steam switch locks on until pushed off. It's easy to use the filling cap and the maximum fill level is clearly shown. You can refill the tank without leaving it to cool first.

CONS It produces a lot of water and is no better at cleaning than

the multi-purpose, glass or fabric cleaning products we compared it against. It's not as good for stains on bathroom tiles and fabric as on other surfaces. Soap scum and red wine remained slightly visible after treatment. There's no real handgrip to make it comfortable to hold and no filling funnel is supplied.

Steaming time is just over seven minutes – not long for cleaning. It's available via mail order.

# Montiss Steam cleaner CSC5375M £36

#### Which? test score 38%

PROS The list of good things we could find to say about this Don't Buy is pretty short. Using the nozzle and brush attachment gives good results on grubby grout and soap-scum covered tiles, in less time than a multipurpose cleaner. We found that it's reasonably easy to attach and remove the tools and it does

produce a lot of steam, which helps with cleaning.

CONS We had problems using it because of the loose-fitting control knob. It takes more than three minutes to heat and the steaming time of just under 7.5 minutes is not a long time for cleaning. You need to leave it to cool for five minutes before adding more water to the tank. It also feels a bit heavy to use. It doesn't come with a filling funnel.

It was reasonable at cleaning glass quickly using the squeegee attachment, but the finish was poor. It was streaky and needed a good wipe afterward. It takes a fair amount of effort to scrub tiles. There is no upholstery tool and it had no effect on a red wine stain on fabric. It's also very poor at refreshing fabric; it became very wet, but didn't lose its creases or doggy smell.
