students. With over 70

teachers and staff serving these students it can be a busy place at times! Despite the large population, there is a sense of family and camaraderie among teachers and students alike. All in all a great place to be a part of!

Tell us why you participate in TerraCycle, and how you involve your organization.

I became involved in TerraCycle to help reduce some of the waste at our school. I was very discouraged to see that our school fills four dumpsters daily. Part of this is due to the fact that the cafeteria serves food on disposable foam trays, multiply that by 1,000+ students and you have a heap of waste! I began a Drink Pouch Brigade at our location, and from there have added several other Brigade programs as they have opened up off of the waiting list.

I like to use our redeemed points to apply to the greenhouse at Mosheim School. Previously the greenhouse had fallen into a state of disarray. With the funds from the TerraCycle program we have been able to involve community members, operate the greenhouse for class visits/projects, and host both Fall and Spring plant sales! I have been able to use our TerraCycle involvement as a talking point with local businesses and receive donations and support to further assist the greenhouse.

The students love bringing their cereal tops back from breakfast each morning to the recycle sorting station. Some students even collect the cereal packaging from other students who weren't saving their packaging previously and bring in 50+
