




Flatten your food wrapper and cut out a 7.5" x 7.5" square. Then cut a rectangle that is 1" x 7.5" to use as a handle.




Punch a hole in each end of the handle .5" in from each end. To get a clean hole punch when punching through food wrapper, it helps to back the wrapper with a thick piece of paper and punch through both layers.












Cut into the first panel of the two fold lines on the left and right sides of the grid as indicated.




To create your basket, fold the cut flaps towards each other so they overlap. You can use a little bit of clear tape to keep in place. Then fold the top edge of the overlapped pieces down by about .75". Tape in place. Repeat for the other side.



Punch a hole about .5" from the top on each side of the basket. Attach your handle on each side with a paper fastener.



To add extra embellishments to your basket, punch holes every .5" around the top edge and weave strips of food wrapper through the holes. Put this eco-treat to use and fill it up with your favorite goodies.
