Chili Cook-Off Rules and Regulations

- Each entrant will pay a \$10 entry fee a portion of which will go to event logistics, including electricity for warmers, tables, serving cups, spoons, napkins, etc.
- A minimum of 2 gallons of chili must be prepared for the public.
- Electricity and tables will be supplied however, each entrant is responsible for providing their own heat source for their entry (i.e., crock pot, hot plate, etc.)
- Each entrant must supply his/her own cooking and serving utensils like ladles (serving cups, spoons, napkins will be provided by BAAI).
- Entrants can decorate their serving area in any way they deem appropriate.
- Each entrant must be present in the tasting area to serve their entry.
- Beans, pasta and rice are approved ingredients for this chili competition.
- Chili must be made from scratch: cooking beginning with raw meats (if not vegetarian), vegetables and spices; complete commercial chili mixes are not permitted.
- Each tester will receive one ticket for a fee of \$5.00 which will be good for a sample of each of the chili selections in the competition.
- Each ticket is good for one vote for “Chili Champ”.
- Each contestant will be provided a contestant number which will be represented by a container in a voting line.
- After sampling each chili recipe, tester will vote by placing their ticket in the contestant container of their choice.
- A contest referee will be present at the voting location at all times to ensure that voting is fair and honest.
