Church Planting Internship

MISSION FOCUS: Church Planting, Children & Youth

DATE: May 25 - Aug. 10, 2018, Orientation May 18 - 20, 2018

Get practical hands on experience as you are part of a church planting team. You will get the opportunity to see what life is like in a Canadian culture where less than 4% of the population are followers of Jesus. You will receive training each week and have the chance to go out in the community where you will learn first hand how to do community mapping, prayer walking, engaging a lost culture, community service projects, gathering people together for activities and events, setting up and being part of a weekly worship gathering, and helping to disciple brand new followers of Jesus. Each week will also consist of 2 kids outreach nights and 1 youth outreach night. We are also in the process of planting our third church in the multiplication network so you will get to be part of this from just about the beginning stages. Church on the Rock is located on the eastern side of Metro Vancouver and has established itself as a church planting multiplication hub center where we make disciples, develop leaders, and send them out to plant new churches in neighborhoods right where the people live. Come be part of this multiplication center and see how lives are being transformed and the kingdom of heaven is being advanced in the Vancouver area.

Religion is central to most South Asians so prepare to make this part of every conversation. Begin your summer at training with other students serving in F2F assignments. You have to be up for the challenge and ready to take the heat!

Ultimate Frisbee is one of the established means by which we are using to engage students on the local campus, so come put your skills to use for the kingdom. We live on a tropical island where 75% of those in the local deaf community are members of the island's Unreached People Groups. You can use your barista skills, ultimate Frisbee or American sign language to engage the community.

Come serve in these three areas: 1. Setting up housing for Short-term Mission Volunteer Teams 2. Serve as hosts at church housing locations. 3. Organize and mobilize the supply stream for beaches (22,000 hotdogs, 400 gallons cocoa, etc.) 4. Organize and lead Beach Outreaches (personal evangelism, kids club, bounce houses, face painting, traffic control, grill masters, cocoa, first aid, etc.) 5. Sustainable Gardens and Sharing the Gospel

MISSION FOCUS: Agriculture, Food Provision, Global Health

For six years CERI has led teams of volunteers to show South Africans how to build "trench gardens" that feed a family of five. Each year the gardens are replicated by the towns people who in turn build multiple gardens. Families visited by team members receive groceries and a gospel witness. This ministry is duplicated by the Africans who learn from team members how to plant a trench garden. Each day of the mission you are tasked to dig trenches, layer trenches with cardboard, straw, cow manure, dig holes for posts, concrete fence posts, install a gate, plant seedlings, and visit homes in the community. No gardening experience needed. You will be taught how to plant a garden. Expect to work long, hard hours. You will also reach children after school hours with activities and a gospel presentation.

Connect with Thai university students and young urban working adults through informal English conversation, hanging out, forming friendships, and sharing your faith with people who have never known a Christian or heard the gospel before. Guitar, singing, drama, sports & your college major can all be ways to connect with people. You and your team will spend your weeks at the Baptist Student Center located in central Bangkok along the Bangkok Sky Train route and at nearby universities. There are 2500 English Center students and thousands of university students who want to meet an American English speaker and practice their English. As your team connects with them, share your faith with them and invite them to many activities in and around Bangkok. You can also invite them on trips to tropical Thailand, so that they can meet your teammates and ultimately hear the Gospel.

MISSION FOCUS: Indigenous People Group, Coffee Growing

Are you adventurous, energetic, motivated, outgoing and spontaneous? Then we need you! Share Bible stories while investigating the worldview of a small indigenous group. When not hiking into remote areas, there are ample opportunities to interact with locals through evangelism and discipleship. Your gifting and talents can open up doors. Allow God to use you for His kingdom! Although there is no corner coffee shop, this is coffee country. Learn the process of making coffee-- from the plant to the cup! Hands On orientation and debrief are hosted in Lima, Peru, where you will learn alongside other students serving in the Americas.

Resolved4Provo is a Gospel Ministry to the Least Reached City and University in the U.S. The Provo area has 250,000+ people and is 0.5% reached with the gospel of Jesus Christ. There are close to 34,000 students and less than 50 students are born-again believers in Jesus. That is 99.85% lost. You will join the local workers to co-labor in the areas of evangelism, bible studies, interfaith dialogues, and prayer walking. You will be trained in evangelism, apologetics, and theology to be better equipped in sharing your faith with the lost people of Provo. You will use gospel appointments as your tool to engage lost students and can expect at least 3 Gospel conversations per week that can move into discipling younger believers on a weekly basis. This is a difficult setting for ministry. Do not let the "hard" turn you away; let it motivate you to come!

MISSION FOCUS: Evangelism & Discipleship of University Students

As a frontliner, you will engage university Muslim students in spiritual conversations that move to the Gospel. As a trainer, you will train, model, and go with national believers to spread the hope of Jesus. Our team will immediately equip you with tools for training. Your goal will be to access the national believers in local campus ministries, teach, and model in evangelism and discipleship. These students have a heart to reach their peers but they often do not know how, and the Muslims are especially neglected due to fear. Through training, you will instill the know how, confidence and immediate obedience. Your goal is to see the Lord raise up a group of students equipped to evangelize and disciple their national peers. Expect to work amongst your gender.

The University of Oregon is a premiere university in beautiful Eugene! It is a campus that is predominantly non-believers (approximately 90% do not have any current connection to faith).
