FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

1. Read Hebrews 11:8-16. How does this passage help shape our perspective of this life? How might it help us in our thinking and planning?
2. Are all of this life's 'toils and troubles' (Psa 90:10) a result of sin? Please review Hebrews 12:3-11. How can we know if God is disciplining us - and how might this affect how we approach difficulties in life?
3. If God actually 'disciplines' us, then can we lose our salvation if we sin badly enough? This would be a great time to discuss whether we can be assured of our salvation in light of Scripture.
4. The Bible speaks often about eternal rewards and of a judgment seat for all (Rom 14:10-12; 2 Cor 5:10, etc.). How does this relate to the cry of Psalm 90:12 and to our lives?
5. Read Luke 16:1-9. What is the point of the parable? How might we apply it to our lives?
6. What are some practical ways we can live our lives wisely, staying focused on what matters and ending well – individually, and corporately?
