## FURTHER UP, FURTHER IN

2. Do you believe there is a final judgment for *all* people? Try to imagine what that will be like. How can it motivate us to change how we live?
3. What are some ways we at Temecula Hills are already involved with sharing the Gospel? How can we help each other be even more effective in winning people for Christ?
4. What are some things that can hold us back personally from telling others about Christ? What relevance does 1 Cor 9:19-23 have for sharing the Gospel?
5. What doctrine was Paul convinced of in 2 Cor 5:14? What can be learned and shared from this verse?
6. Did Christ die for all people, or only the elect? (just to stir up some fun!) Either way, what applications can be drawn for every individual from 2 Cor 5:14-15?
7. **Sunday's teaching talked about** being in Christ vs. in Adam. Why is that distinction important?
8. What does it mean to be a "**new** creation in Christ" (2 Cor 5:17)? What changes have you seen in your life since becoming a Christian? Where is God working now in your life?
