1. As we look forward to service Sunday this coming week, what are **some ways you've considered serving?**
2. Read 2 Cor 6:11 – 7:1. **What does it mean, to be 'unequally yoked' in 6:14? What does it not mean?**
3. What criteria can we use to **assess God's will for potential relationships?** (Deut 22:10; John 17:14-19; 1 Cor 5:9-10; 15:33; Eph 5:7-11)
4. What should we do if we are already unequally yoked? What Scriptures might apply?
5. Who remembers the chiasmic in 2 Cor 6:16-18? What did it emphasize and show us?
6. Read John 14:23. What other verses speak of an intimacy between **the Lord and His followers?** **Have you ever experienced God's presence in a special or unique way?**
7. **What are some practical ways we can/should 'separate' ourselves unto God?** What can influence or draw our hearts away from devotion to the Lord?
8. **What is meant by 'defilement of body and spirit' in 2 Cor 7:1, and 'bringing holiness to completion?' Why should I pursue personal holiness if I'm already saved?** (Matt 5:8; 23:25-26; 2 Cor 6:1-3; 1John 3:1-3, etc.)
9. Why is God so persistent in pursuing our hearts? What are some practical ways we can respond to His love, and deepen our relationship with Him?
