1. Have you ever experienced someone being ashamed or unashamed of you? How did that make you feel? How does Hebrews 11:16 impact you in light of that?
2. Read Genesis 22:1-14. What stands out to you about this story of surrendering faith?
3. In your life, can you think of a time God has asked you to surrender to Him in faith?
4. Read Hebrews 11:17-19. Where do we see Abraham banking on God's promises here? In your life, what does it look like to "consider"—or calculate on God's promises? What are some promises of God that you count on regularly?
5. Read Hebrews 11:13-22, and consider how is this entire passage is encouraging us to look beyond the grave in hope. What does this look like in your life on a day-to-day basis?
6. How do the examples of faith in Hebrews 11 point us towards Jesus?
7. Can you think of a time when someone else's faith pointed you towards Jesus? What happened, and how did they point you to Jesus? How might God be pointing others towards Jesus through you right now?
