Notes

The above table does not include 3 confirmed cases of BSE in 2 animals which died in December 2005 and 1 animal which died in August 2008 on a Somerset farm. These cases were identified under the compulsory BSE surveillance programme, an aspect of which requires the UK to test all fallen stock cattle aged 24 months or over and from 2009, cattle aged 48 months and over. The dates of birth of these animals are unknown although they are likely to have been born after July 1996. Disease was confirmed on 24 January 2006 and 30 September 2008.
