



Winter varieties of Brassica crops.

These varieties are planted in summer and overwinter in the field. They have been bred to have characteristics of winter hardiness and/or vernalisation so they overwinter and are harvested in the spring.

The varieties on this list will count as 'Winter' varieties for the purposes of meeting the Crop Diversification requirements. Any other species grown will, by default, count as 'Spring' varieties.
