## Geographical names policy

Geographical names in Syria are found written in Arabic, which is the country's official language. Where possible names should be taken from official Syrian sources and romanised using the BGN/PCGN Romanisation system for Arabic<sup>1</sup>.

It should also be noted that Roman-script forms may be encountered which differ from those arising from the application of the BGN/PCGN Romanisation system for Arabic.

## Languages

Arabic is the official language of Syria. Modern Standard Arabic (MSA) is used for official written purposes. The dialect spoken in Syria is Levantine Arabic. Arabic is a Semitic language and is written from right to left. The Arabic alphabet consists of 28 letters, in addition to which there are several vocalisation marks which are not usually written.

Kurdish (in its Kurmanji form) is widely spoken in the Kurdish regions of Syria. Many educated Syrians also speak English and French. Armenian and Turkish (South Azeri dialect) are spoken among the Armenian and Turkmen minorities respectively. Aramaic is spoken among Arameans and Assyrians. Syriac is used as the liturgical language of various Syriac denominations. Circassian languages are also spoken.

**Administrative structure**

Syria is divided into 14 first-order administrative divisions, known as governorates or provinces (*Muḥāfaẓah* in Arabic). These are sub-divided into 60 districts (*Minṭaqah* in Arabic)<sup>3</sup>, and one city, Madīnat Dimashq (Damascus). These districts are further divided into sub-districts (*Nāḥiyah* in Arabic).
