JUDGMENT

1. The respondent's application for an extension of time in which to present its response form ET3 is refused.
2. The claimant's complaint of unlawful disability discrimination is dismissed upon withdrawal by the claimant.
3. The claimant's complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £1,412.64 being wages unlawfully deducted. That is a net amount and the respondent shall be responsible for the payment of any income tax and national insurance contributions thereon.
